**RULING GRANTING PACIFICORP'S REVISED MOTION FOR CONFIDENTIAL
TREATMENT OF THE POWER PURCHASE AGREEMENT**

On June 5, 2026, PacifiCorp filed a Motion for Confidential Treatment of the Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) (Motion) between PacifiCorp and US SFR LLC (US SFR).¹

The uncontested Motion was filed pursuant to Commission Rule of Practice and Procedure (Rules) Rule 11.4 and requests the Commission prohibit public disclosure of the PPA. The PPA is a negotiated bilateral contract between PacifiCorp and US SFR related to the nuclear Naughton Power Plant. The Motion requests the Commission grant their request to maintain the PPA as confidential until December 31, 2036 based on Decision (D.)06-06-066 and California Government Code Section §7922.000. The Motion argues that the disclosure of the terms of the PPA would harm and place PacifiCorp and US SFR at a competitive disadvantage in related future contact negotiations.

Having reviewed the Motion, the public interest in maintaining disclosure outweighs the public interest in disclosure. The ability of PacifiCorp and US SFR

to negotiate future PPAs to procure power for public use at reasonable terms outweighs the public interest in disclosure. Furthermore, the Motion's requested duration of confidential treatment of the PPA until December 31, 2036 is reasonable.

Having reviewed the Motion there is sufficient legal and factual support to find good cause to designate the PPA confidential and prohibit public disclosure until December 31, 2026.

IT IS RULED that:

1. There is good cause to grant the Motion for Confidential Treatment of the Power Purchase Agreement
2. The Motion for Confidential Treatment of the Power Purchase Agreement is granted and the Power Purchase Agreement shall remain confidential from public disclosure until December 31, 2036.
