Pursuant to Rule 11.5 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the California Public Utilities Commission (the “Commission”), Pacific Gas and Electric Company (“PG&E”) and the Public Advocates Office at the California Public Utilities Commission (“Cal Advocates” and with PG&E the “Parties”) respectfully file this Joint Motion to Seal a Portion of the Evidentiary Record¹ (“Joint Motion to Seal”) to seal the confidential versions of portions of their written testimony and supporting attachments that the Parties move to admit into the record of the above-captioned proceeding (PGE-02C, PGE-03C, PGE-04C, CA-02-C, CA-02-SA-C, CA-03-C, CA-03-SA-C, CA-04-C, CA-04-SA-C, CA-06-SA-C, CA-08-C, and CA-08-SA-C; collectively the “Confidential Exhibits”).

Concurrent with this motion, PG&E and Cal Advocates are filing a Joint Motion to Admit Exhibits into the Record, including the Confidential Exhibits identified in this Joint Motion to Seal. The confidential information included in the Confidential Exhibits includes sensitive corporate records, personal information, and other sensitive information that, if disclosed, could be harmful to PG&E or other entities as described in the confidentiality

declarations submitted herewith. By this Joint Motion to Seal, the Parties move the Commission for an order granting confidential treatment of these portions of the record.

I. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

On November 14, 2025, PG&E filed Application 25-11-001 requesting review and recovery of costs associated with the 2019 Kincade Fire and 2021 Dixie Fire under AB 1054 (“Application”), which included information designated as confidential. On May 4, 2026, Cal Advocates served intervenor testimony which included information designated as confidential by PG&E and other third parties. On June 19, 2026, PG&E served its rebuttal testimony, which included information designated as confidential. Accounting for re-service for errata, the service dates of the final versions of each Confidential Exhibit are provided in the following table:

And certain portions of the supporting attachments to Cal Advocates' testimony also quote or reference confidential information; accordingly, CA-02-SA-C, CA-03-SA-C, CA-04-SA-C, CA-06-SA-C, and CA-08-SA-C contain red boxes marking the confidential information.
