On August 17, 2026, Union Pacific Railroad (KWS) filed a motion requesting an extension of time to file and serve its rebuttal testimony from August 24, 2026, to September 8, 2026. The motion stated that counsels for the Keene Customer Parties (Clean Water Action, National Chavez Center, and Delores Huerta Foundation) and Cal Advocates were informed of the motion and did not oppose it.
