Subject: Email ruling re Advice Letter A.26-06-017 - CorEnergy et al, Transfer of Control; Email Correspondence

To all parties concerned with the above-captioned matter, A.26-06-017, *Joint Application of CorEnergy Infrastructure Trust, Inc. and CMH Acquisition Company, LLC, pursuant to Section 854 of the Public Utilities Code, for Authority to Transfer Control of San Pablo Bay Pipeline Company, LLC (PLC-29) and Crimson California Pipeline, L.P. (PLC-26)*:

Yesterday, September 1, 2026, counsel for the applicants notified the service list that the transfer of control requested in the application has taken place, and asked about how to submit the required Advice Letter from ordering paragraph 2 of the decision approving the transaction, D.26-08-013. That ordering paragraph provides the following:

CMH Acquisition Company, LLC / California Resources Corporation shall file a Tier 1 Advice Letter (Advice Letter) with the California Public Utilities Commission's Energy Division to provide notice that the transfer of control is finalized. The Advice Letter must be filed within 20 working days of the completion of the transaction. The Advice Letter shall be served on the service list for this proceeding, and Application (A.) 26-02-020, A.25-01-009, and A.24-01 016.

Applicants' request was as follows:

Dear [Administrative Law Judge] ALJ Thomas: The transaction approved in D.26-08-013 closed today and we are getting ready to file the Tier 1 Advice Letter required under Ordering Paragraph 2 of the decision. The Ordering Paragraph requires "CMH Acquisition Company, LLC / California Resources Corporation" to file the Advice Letter. Because neither CMH Acquisition Company, LLC nor California Resources Corporation has previously filed an Advice Letter and we do not expect that they will file one in the future (and because we think that it would cleaner from a jurisdictional perspective if the utilities file the Advice Letter), we would like to comply by having the utilities (San Pablo Bay Pipeline and Crimson California Pipeline) file the Advice Letter on behalf of their new parent companies. Do you think that this would be okay? Please let me know if I should direct my inquiry to someone else at the Commission.

ALJ Thomas directed counsel to serve the service list for this proceeding with the above note, which was done on the same day as the note was sent, September 1, 2026.

Good cause appearing, the utilities (San Pablo Bay Pipeline and Crimson California Pipeline) may comply with ordering paragraph 2 by filing the Advice Letter on behalf of their new parent companies as requested. The Advice Letter shall demonstrate compliance with ordering paragraph 2 by explaining why the Advice Letter is being filed by the utilities on behalf of the parent companies named in the ordering paragraph.

IT IS SO RULED.

The Commission's Docket Office shall reopen this proceeding and file this ruling, and then reclose the proceeding.
