**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING STAYING DISCONNECTION AND
RESETTING THE HEARING DATE**

Calin Young (Complainant) filed a complaint against Southern California Edison Company (SCE) on July 29, 2026. The complaint was registered as Case (C.) 26-07-079. A notice to answer complaint (notice) was issued on August 13, 2026. The notice required that SCE file an answer to the complaint by September 2, 2026, and set an evidentiary hearing for Wednesday, October 7, 2026, at 10 a.m. by videoconference.

On August 14, 2026, SCE filed a request for permission to disconnect Complainant's service, or in the alternative require the Complainant to pay the outstanding bills to the Commission to be held in escrow pending resolution of the complaint, or to require the Complainant to make a certified payment of not

less than \$2,000 and to remain current on all bills during the pendency of the proceeding. Complainant opposes the requests.

1. SCE SHALL MAINTAIN SERVICE DURING THE PENDENCY OF THE PROCEEDING

SCE's request to disconnect Complainant's service is denied. SCE shall maintain the status quo during the proceeding or until further ruling from the Commission. Complainant is not required to deposit funds with the Commission or SCE to maintain service. However, Complainant remains subject to all lawfully imposed bills and charges.

2. EVIDENTIARY HEARING WILL BE HELD ON SEPTEMBER 10, 2026

In order to expedite a final resolution of this proceeding, the evidentiary hearing date is advanced to September 10, 2026 at 10 a.m. The hearing set for October 7, 2026, is vacated.

Complainant and Defendant must appear in an ECP Hearing set before Administrative Law Judge Jacob Rambo on Wednesday, October 7, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. by WebEx (Virtual) at:
