Subject: A.26-03-002: Email Ruling Directing Additional Information

To the Service List for A.26-03-002:

On August 24, 2027, the assigned ALJ issued a ruling directing the filing of additional information, including a map depicting Velocity IG Operations LLC's (Velocity) proposed construction activities. On August 27, 2026, Velocity provided a geographical map depicting the areas of California in which it initially proposes to construct facilities or offer services. Velocity labeled the map "Confidential Exhibit A" and concurrently filed a motion to for leave to file the map under seal.

There is the public interest in knowing where construction activities may occur. Accordingly, Velocity shall provide:

1. A **public** map as required by Rule 3.1(c) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure and 11.c of the application for applicants proposing full facilities-based construction activities.

If there are clarifications needed regarding the required information, Velocity may contact the assigned Administrative Law Judge Patricia Miles by email at patricia.miles@cpuc.ca.gov **and** Assistant Chief Administrative Law Judge Robyn Purchia by email at robyn.purchia@cpuc.ca.gov, copying the service list.

Within 10 days of the date of this ruling, Velocity shall provide the additional information as directed herein. Failure to provide the additional information may result in dismissal of A.26-03-002 for failure to prosecute. Velocity's filing must be titled "Response to Administrative Law Judge Inquiry," otherwise a new protest period will be triggered.

IT IS SO RULED.
