Director Osborn and Mr. Lai,

Thank you again for your presentations during the Workshop yesterday regarding the current Staff Proposal.

As discussed during the Workshop, the wireless carriers would like to be able to review and consider the data and analysis relied on by the staff in preparing their recommendations. As a follow-up to that discussion, CTIA, AT&T Mobility, Verizon Wireless and T-Mobile respectfully request the following data which will, among other things, help ensure that the Commission has the benefit of a fulsome record as this proceeding moves forward.

1. Cal OES Outage Data – all data, notes, analysis and workpapers regarding the Cal OES Community Isolation Reports used by staff to support or develop the statements or recommendations in the Staff Proposal.
 - This request includes any data, notes, analysis and workpapers used to prepare the information in pages 18 – 23, 27 – 37 as well as the proposed Cal OES Community Isolation Outage Standard and the Network Availability by PUMA Standard.
 - To the extent any of the data, analysis or workpapers were obtained directly from Cal OES, or its vendor, please identify those accordingly.
 - In order to address confidentiality concerns, please provide any data, analysis and workpapers regarding a particular carriers' Reports only to that carrier.
 - Aggregated and anonymized data, analysis and workpapers can be provided to all of the carriers
 - Alternatively, all the data, analysis and workpapers can be provided to CTIA's external representative and it will ensure that carriers receive only anonymized and aggregated data or data pertaining to a particular carrier.
2. PPH Analysis – all data, notes, analysis, transcripts and workpapers regarding the staff's reliance on statements made at the PPH's in this proceeding to support any of the statements or recommendations in the Staff Proposal, including but not limited to the categorization of the PPH comments on page 7 of the Staff Proposal.
3. Any other data, notes, analysis and workpapers relied upon by the Staff in preparing or developing and of the statements or recommendations in the Staff Proposal, including but not limited to the maps, tables, and figures in the Staff Proposal.

Given the current schedule, we further request that the information requested above be provided by next Wednesday, September 2, 2026. If the current schedule is extended, we can accommodate accordingly of course.
