Pursuant to Rule 8.2 of the California Public Utilities Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, Small Business Utility Advocates (SBUA) amends its prior notice and gives three business days’ advance notice that SBUA intends to hold a remote video-conferencing ex parte meeting regarding intervenor compensation matters in Rulemaking (R.) 25-06-019 and R.18-12-005. The meeting will address SBUA’s pending request for a significant financial hardship determination in R.25-06-019 and the Proposed Decision Granting Compensation to Small Business Utility Advocates for Substantial Contribution to Decision 24-12-005 and Denying Compensation for Resolution WSEB-1 and Other Matters in R.18-12-005.

The meeting was previously noticed for Wednesday, September 16, 2026, from approximately 12:30 to 1:00 p.m., but did not occur as scheduled due to a scheduling conflict affecting Commission staff availability.
