**MOTION OF THE PUBLIC ADVOCATES OFFICE FOR LEAVE
TO FILE UNDER SEAL ITS CONFIDENTIAL REPLY COMMENTS
ON THE STAFF PROPOSAL; [PROPOSED] ORDER**

Pursuant to Rule 11.4 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the California Public Utilities Commission, the Public Advocates Office at the California Public Utilities Commission (Cal Advocates) respectfully submits this Motion for Leave to File Under Seal *The Public Advocates Office Confidential Reply Comments on the Staff Proposal* (Motion).

On September 15, 2026, and concurrently with this Motion, Cal Advocates filed *The Public Advocates Office Reply Comments on the Staff Proposal* (Reply Comments) in the above-referenced proceeding. In its Reply Comments, Cal Advocates discusses issues that are contested in this proceeding and relies on information that AT&T Mobility LLC (New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (U 3060 C); AT&T Mobility Wireless Operations Holdings, Inc. (U 3021 C); and Santa Barbara Cellular Systems, Ltd. (U 3015 C) (collectively, “AT&T”) claims is confidential.

Cal Advocates has made every effort to either aggregate or anonymize information that AT&T claims is confidential. However, the specificity of the issues requires Cal Advocates to reference necessary information to support its arguments in the Reply Comments. Thus, Cal Advocates has marked certain portions of the Reply Comments as confidential pursuant to AT&T’s designations and has indicated those confidential portions in the public version of the Reply Comments by redacting certain text. Cal Advocates will be prejudiced if it is unable to include certain information that AT&T

claims is confidential. Accordingly, Cal Advocates respectfully requests that the Administrative Law Judge grant it permission to file under seal the unredacted, confidential version of the Reply Comments.
