**JOINT MOTION OF PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY (U 39 M), PUBLIC
ADVOCATES OFFICE, AND THE UTILITY REFORM NETWORK TO ADMIT
INTO EVIDENCE VARIOUS EXHIBITS FOR THE 2027 GRC UPDATE PHASE**

Pursuant to Rule 11.1 of the California Public Utilities Commission’s (“Commission”) Rules of Practice and Procedure (“Rules”), Pacific Gas and Electric Company (“PG&E”) and the parties listed in the caption above jointly move to identify and admit into evidence various exhibits for the 2027 GRC Update Phase. Pursuant to Rule 1.8, counsel for the following parties have authorized PG&E to file this motion on their behalf: Public Advocates Office at the California Public Utilities Commission (Cal Advocates) and The Utility Reform Network (TURN). PG&E, Cal Advocates, and TURN are collectively referred to herein as the “Joint Moving Parties”.

I. BACKGROUND

On July 31, 2026, PG&E filed a motion requesting permission to submit update testimony on labor cost changes based on contract negotiations and revenue requirement changes to reflect new tax laws. On August 11, 2026, ALJ Larsen issued a Ruling granting PG&E’s motion. In accordance with the initial schedule set forth in the Ruling, PG&E served the update testimony on August 14, 2026.

Cal Advocates and TURN conducted discovery on the topics covered in PG&E’s update testimony. Following subsequent discussions among parties required by the Ruling, the Joint Moving Parties determined that intervenor testimony and evidentiary hearings were not necessary. In lieu of evidentiary hearings, the Joint Moving Parties respectfully request the exhibits listed in Table 1 be admitted into the evidentiary record.
