CPUC TO HOLD MEETING TO HEAR UPDATES FROM SCE ON PSPS CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN

SAN FRANCISCO, February 25, 2021 - The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), in its ongoing actions to reduce the impacts of utility Public Safety Power Shutoffs (PSPS), will hold a public meeting for Southern California Edison (SCE) to provide an update on its Corrective Action Plan following a January public [meeting](#) the CPUC held to address the operational deficiencies identified in the utility's execution of its 2020 PSPS events.

WHAT: Southern California Edison 2020 PSPS Corrective Action Plan Meeting

WHEN: March 1, 2021, 1 - 4:30 p.m.

WHERE: Remote access via webcast or conference line. Participation information is below.

WHY: The CPUC is requiring Southern California Edison to publicly address their 2020 PSPS Corrective Action Plan.
