ORDER EXTENDING STATUTORY DEADLINE

Summary

This decision extends the statutory deadline in this proceeding to March 26, 2025.

1. Background and Justification

Public Utilities Code (Pub. Util. Code) Section 1701.5(a) provides that the Commission shall resolve the issues raised in the scoping memo of a ratesetting proceeding within 18 months of the date the proceeding is initiated unless the Commission makes a written determination that the deadline cannot be met and issues an order extending the deadline. The current statutory deadline for resolving this proceeding is January 26, 2025.

A proposed decision has been issued and comments are due in January 2025. An extension of the statutory deadline until March 26, 2025, is necessary to allow the Commission adequate time to consider the comments on the proposed decision and then deliberate before completing this proceeding.

2. Waiver of Comment Period

Under Rule 14.6(c)(4) of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, the Commission may waive the otherwise applicable 30-day period for public review and comment on a decision that extends the 18-month deadline set forth in Pub. Util. Code § 1701.5. Under the circumstances of this proceeding, it is appropriate to waive the 30-day period for public review and comment.

3. Assignment of Proceeding

Karen Douglas is the assigned Commissioner and Jason Jungreis is the assigned Administrative Law Judge and the presiding officer in this proceeding.

Findings of Fact

1. The current statutory deadline for resolving A.23-01-013 is January 26, 2025.
2. A.23-01-013 cannot be completed by January 26, 2025.
3. An extension of the statutory deadline until March 26, 2025, is necessary to allow adequate time to complete this proceeding.

Conclusion of Law

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Commission under Pub. Util. Code § 1701.5(a), the statutory deadline should be extended until March 26, 2025.

IT IS ORDERED that the statutory deadline for completion of this proceeding is extended until March 26, 2025.
