ORDER EXTENDING STATUTORY DEADLINE

Summary

This decision extends the statutory deadline for completion of Case (C.) 19-03-005 until July 14, 2025.

1. Background

Based on the filing date of this Rulemaking, Public Utilities (Pub. Util.)

Code § 1701.2(i) provides that adjudicatory proceedings shall be resolved within

12 months of the date the proceeding is initiated, unless the Commission makes a written determination that the deadline cannot be met and issues an order extending the deadline. In this proceeding, pursuant to Pub. Util. Code

§ 1701.2(i), the assigned Commissioner's Scoping Memo and Ruling specified a 12-month statutory deadline from the date this proceeding was initiated for resolving this proceeding. The current statutory deadline is January 13, 2025.

Presiding Officer's Decision Granting Southern California Edison Company's Motion To Dismiss (POD) was issued on December 13, 2024.

Additional time is needed for the time to toll on the appeal period and request for review period for the POD, ending on January 13, 2025. Accordingly, we conclude that it is appropriate to extend the statutory deadline in this C.19-03-005 proceeding for at least 180 days, until on or before July 14, 2025.

2. Waiver of Comment Period

Under Rule 14.6(c)(4) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the Commission may waive the otherwise applicable 30-day period for public review and comment on a decision extending the deadline for resolving adjudicatory proceedings set forth in Public Utilities Code Section 1701.2(i)). Under the circumstances of this proceeding, it is appropriate to waive the 30-day period for public review and comment.

3. Assignment of Proceeding

John Reynolds is the assigned Commissioner and Andrea D. McGary is the assigned Administrative Law Judge and the presiding officer in this proceeding.

Findings of Fact

- 1. D.24-11-019 extended the statutory deadline for C.19-03-005 until January 13, 2025.
- 2. Presiding Officer's Decision Granting Southern California Edison Company's Motion To Dismiss was issued on December 13, 2024, closing proceeding C.19-03-005.

- 3. Additional time is needed for the time to toll on the appeal period and/or request for review period, ending on January 13, 2025 for the C.19-03-005 December 13, 2024 POD.
- 4. An extension of the statutory deadline until July 14, 2025, is necessary to allow adequate time for the appeal and request for review period to toll, and for the proceeding to close.

Conclusion of Law

1. Pursuant to the authority granted to the Commission under Pub. Util.

Code § 1701.2(i), the statutory deadline should be extended to July 14, 2025.

IT IS ORDERED that the statutory deadline for completion of Case 19-03-005 is extended until July 14, 2025.
