RESOLUTION

**GRANTING A THIRD EXTENSION OF TIME REQUIRED FOR CONSTRUCTION OF
A NEW GRADE-SEPARATED CROSSING OF PLACER PARKWAY OVER UNION
PACIFIC RAILROAD TRACKS IN UNINCORPORATED PLACER COUNTY.**

In a letter dated October 20, 2025, received on November 4, 2025, the County of Placer (County) requests a third extension of time, from March 28, 2026, to March 28, 2028, to comply with the provisions of the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission/CPUC) Decision (D.)19-03-019.


D.19-03-019, effective March 28, 2019, authorized the County to construct an overhead grade-separated crossing (crossing) at milepost 112.70 over Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) tracks and Placer Parkway in an unincorporated area of Placer County. The crossing will be identified as CPUC Crossing No. 001C-112.70-A and United States Department of Transportation Number 976258N. The authorization period set forth in D.19-03-019 expired on March 28, 2022. The Commission's Rail Safety Division (RSD) granted an extension of time on August 9, 2023, that extended the authorization period to March 28, 2024. The RSD granted a second extension on August 23, 2024, that extended the authorization period to March 28, 2026.

The County is requesting additional time extension because of delays in acquiring the needed right of way for the project, with the original delay resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic.

The RSD finds that there has been no substantial change in circumstances since granting the original authority. UPRR concurred with granting this extension. RSD recommends the issuance of this resolution.

IT IS RESOLVED that the County of Placer is granted a two-year extension of time from March 28, 2026, to March 28, 2028, to exercise the authority granted in D.19-03-019. In all other respects, D.19-03-019 shall remain in full force and effect.

This resolution is issued pursuant to Resolution Number ET-1367 and memorandum by the Executive Director dated April 6, 1988, and is effective today, January 15, 2026.
