ORDER EXTENDING STATUTORY DEADLINE**Summary**

This decision extends the statutory deadline for completion of Case (C.) 25-08-021 to October 30, 2026.

1. Background

Public Utilities (Pub. Util.) Code Section (§) 1701.2(i) provides that adjudicatory proceedings shall be resolved within 12 months of the date the proceeding is initiated, unless the Commission makes a written determination that the deadline cannot be met and issues an order extending the deadline. The current statutory deadline for this proceeding is August 28, 2026.

On August 28, 2025 the California Solar and Storage Association filed a Complaint against Pacific Gas and Electric Company and Southern California Edison Company alleging ongoing damages to its member companies caused by gross and repeated violation of interconnection timelines in Rule 21.

On December 12, 2025, the assigned Administrative Law Judge held a prehearing conference to address the issues of law and fact, determine the need for a hearing, set the schedule for resolving the matter, and address other matters as necessary.

On May 6, 2026, the assigned Commissioner issued a Scoping Memo and Ruling to set forth the issues, need for hearing, schedule, category, and other matters necessary to scope this proceeding.

The statutory deadline for C.25-08-021 should be extended to allow time for the Commission to resolve this proceeding. Therefore, the statutory deadline of this proceeding is extended to October 30, 2026.

2. Waiver of Comment Period

Under Rule 14.6(c)(4) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the Commission may waive the otherwise applicable 30-day period for public review and comment on a decision extending the deadline for resolving adjudicatory proceedings set forth in Pub. Util. Code §1701.2(i). Under the circumstances of this proceeding, it is appropriate to waive the 30-day period for public review and comment.

3. Assignment of Proceeding

Matthew Baker is the assigned Commissioner and Hazlyn Fortune is the assigned Administrative Law Judge and presiding officer in this proceeding.

Findings of Fact

1. C.25-08-021 was filed on August 28, 2025.
2. The current statutory deadline for C.25-08-021 is August 28, 2026.
3. C.25-08-021 cannot be completed by August 28, 2026.
4. An extension of the statutory deadline to October 30, 2026, is necessary to resolve the issues and complete this proceeding.

Conclusion of Law

1. Pursuant to the authority granted to the Commission under Pub. Util. Code § 1701.2(i), the statutory deadline should be extended to October 30, 2026.

IT IS ORDERED that the statutory deadline in this proceeding is extended to October 30, 2026.
