Coverage Map for Air Voice Wireless ETC Service Area

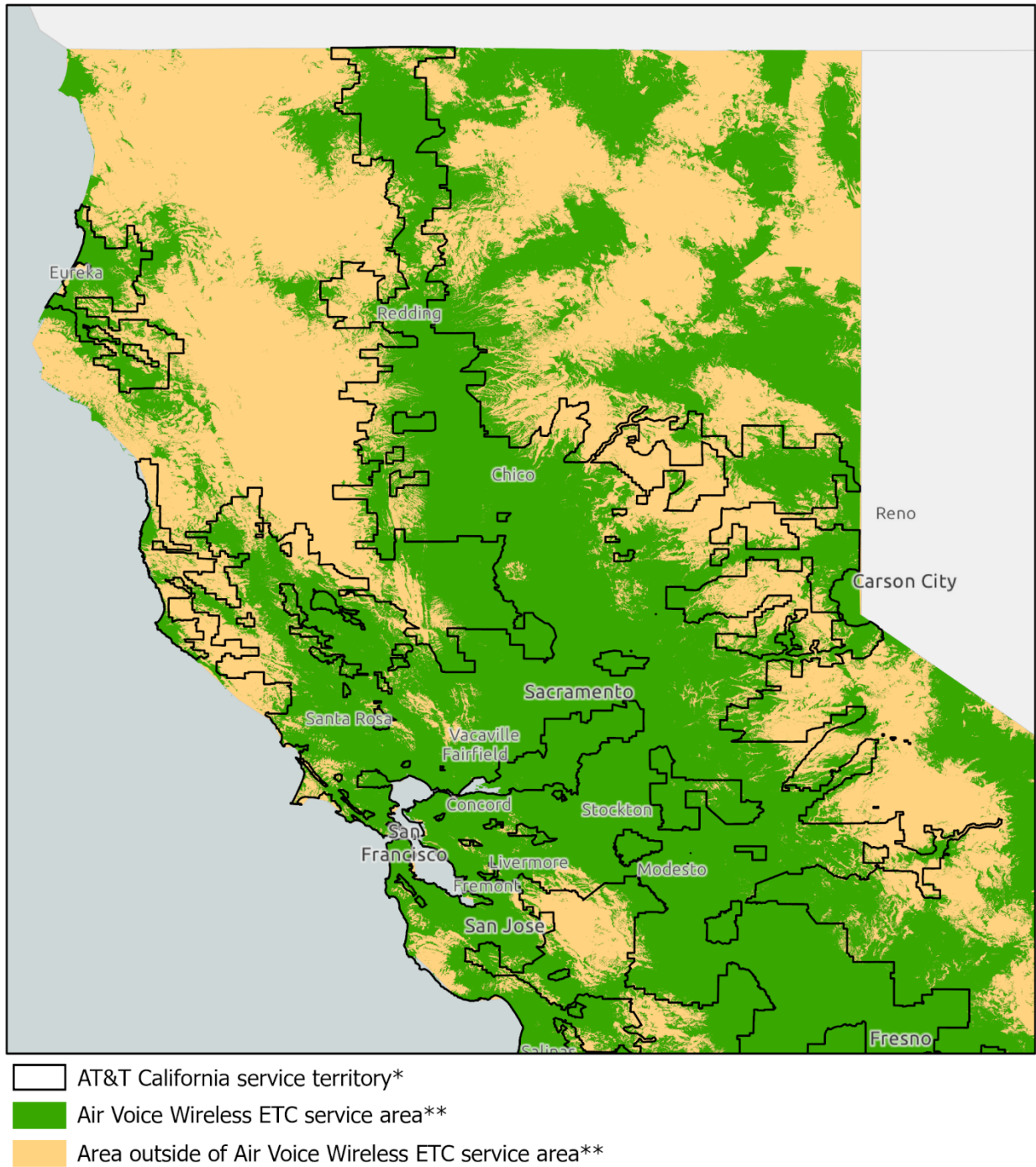

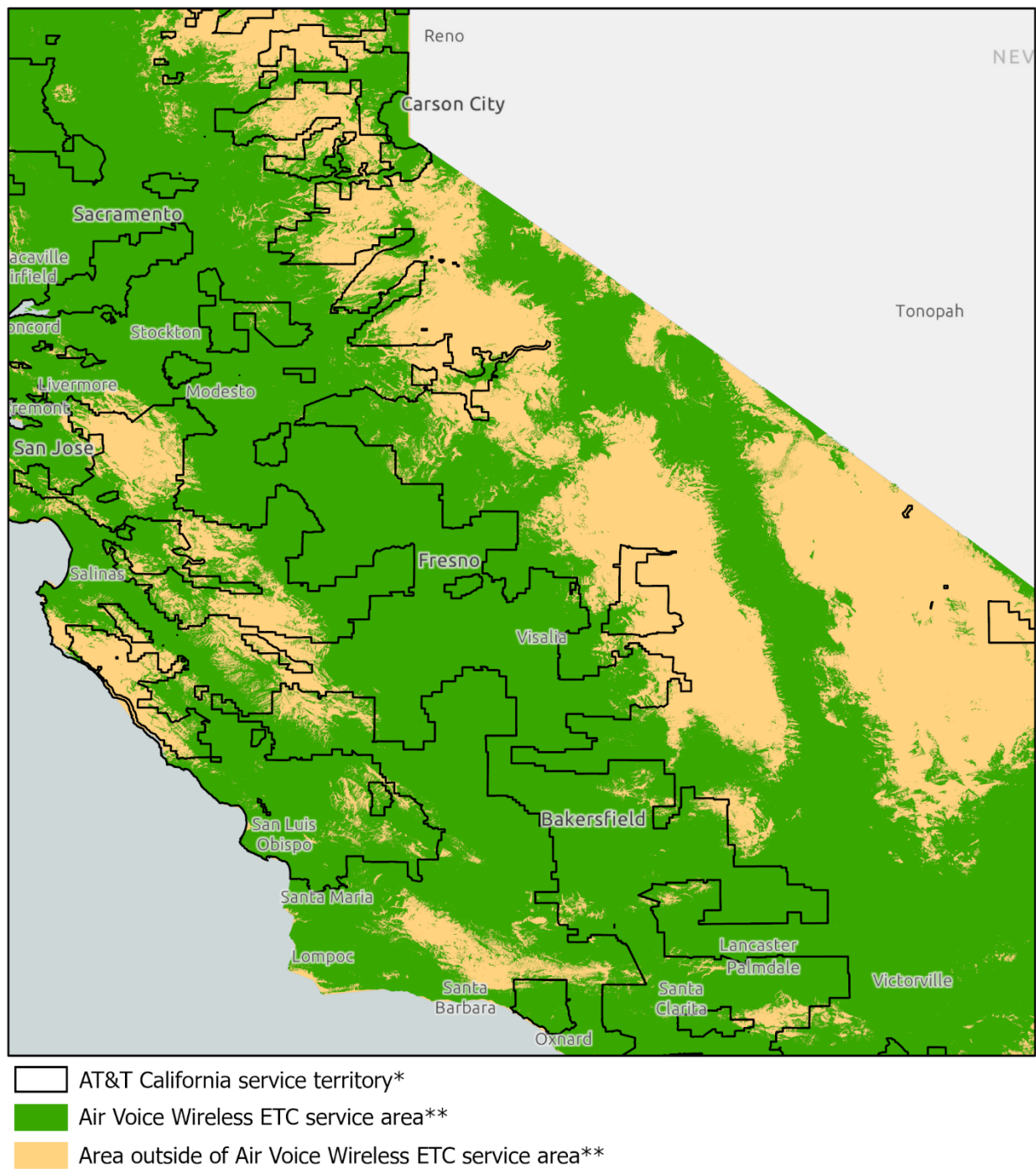
Coverage Map for Air Voice Wireless ETC Service Area

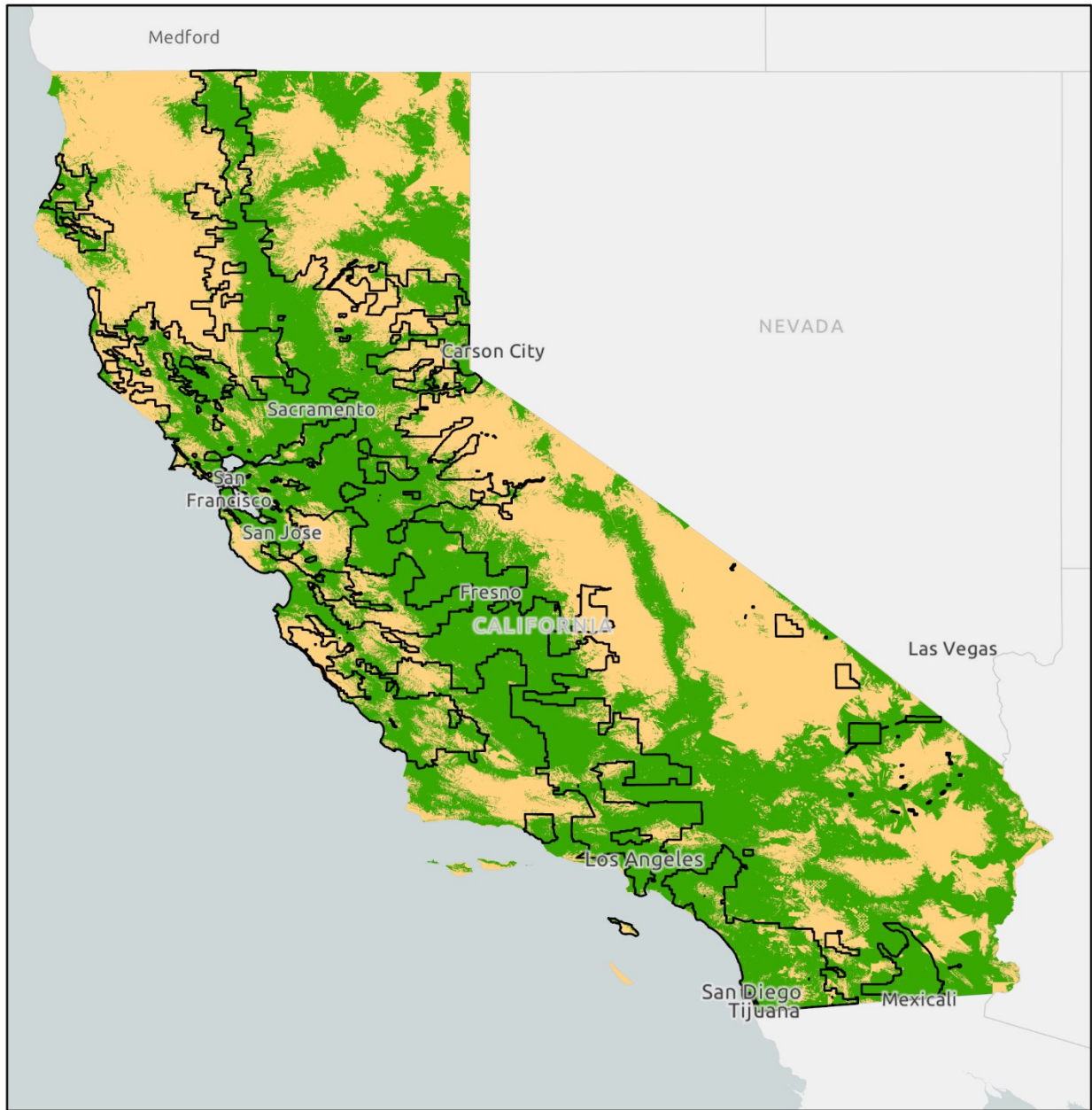

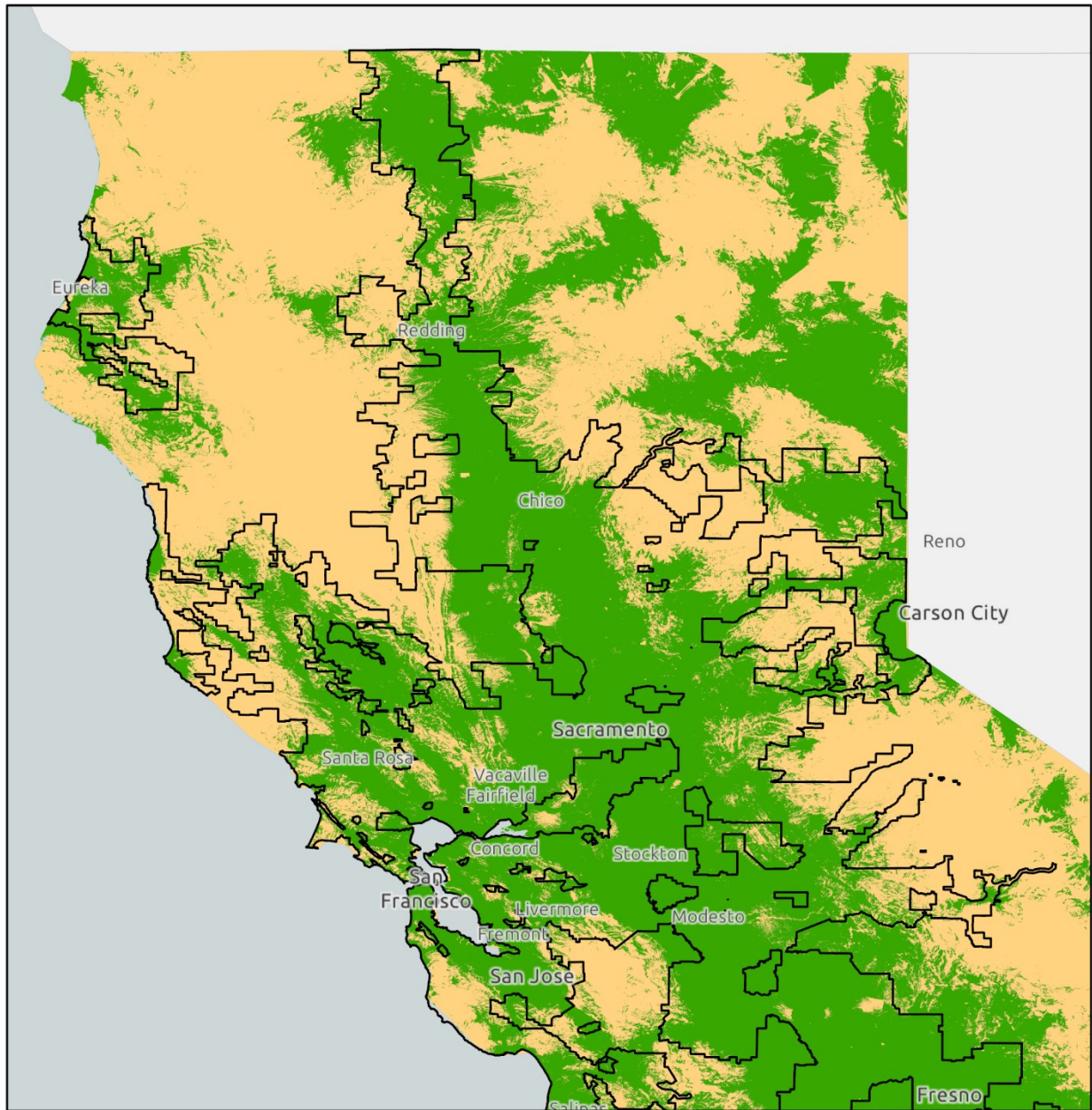

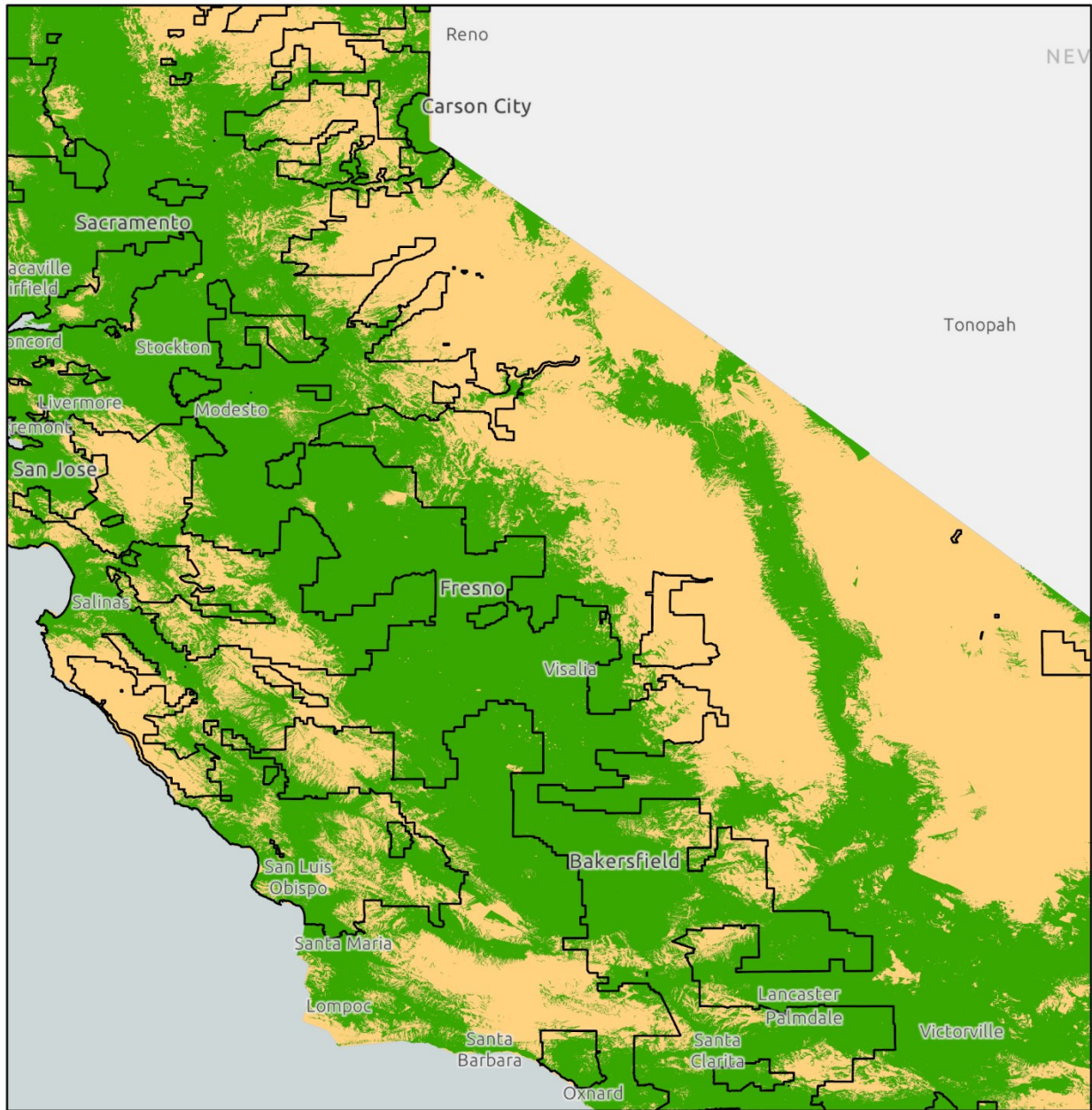

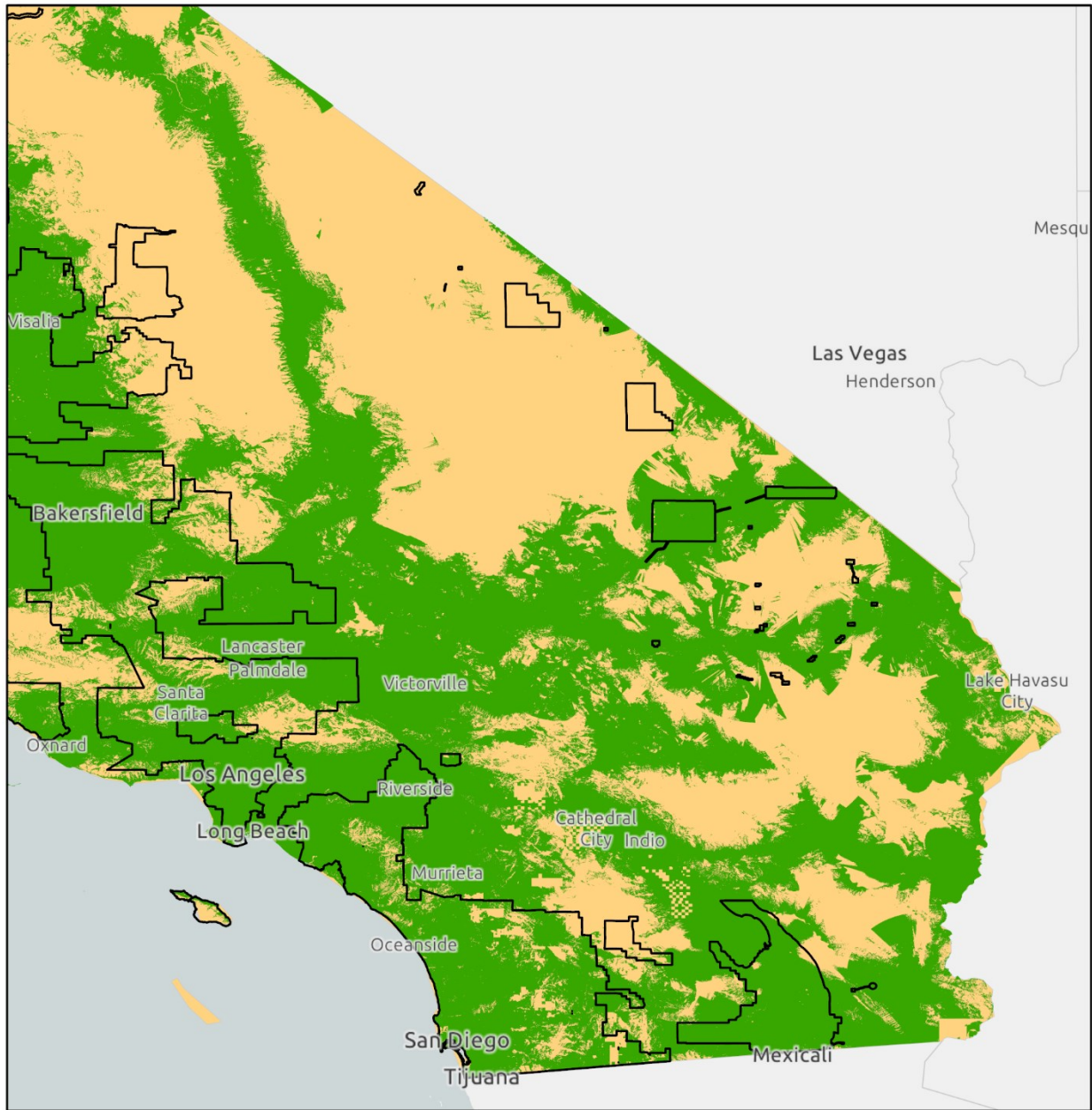

CD has concerns about how AmeriMex, a reseller that obtains services from an underlying facilities-based carrier and another reseller, could commit to provide service to a Lifeline customer within the service area but outside of its existing network coverage as required by FCC rules ... To ensure that AmeriMex complies with its obligation to provide service to prospective Lifeline customers within the network service area pursuant to FCC rules, CD staff recommends that the Commission require AmeriMex to submit an Information Only report quarterly to the Communications Division Director.” (T-17455, at 5-6)
 - The Commission staff did not repeat these concerns in the 2016 resolution expanding AmeriMex’s ETC service area to wherever its underlying carriers serve retail customers. Instead, the Commission stated that “While wireless mobile phone service and E-911 and/or 911 connections have limitations, approval of AmeriMex’s request will expand its service area to a greater number of consumers resulting in improved access to public safety services. The Commission reminds AmeriMex of its consumer disclosure responsibilities regarding wireless location accuracy.” (T-17543, at 3)

Coverage Map for AmeriMex Communications ETC Service Area

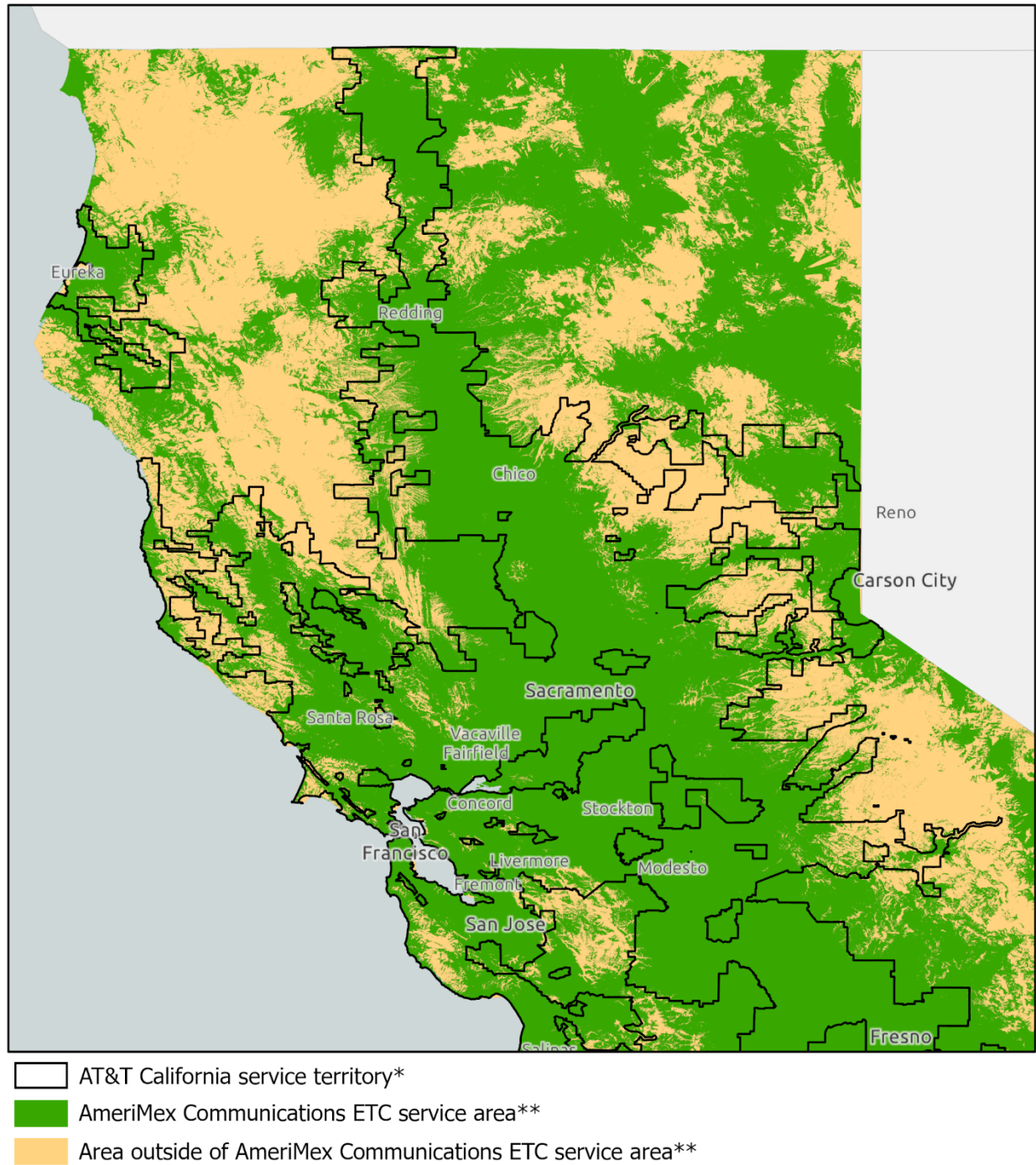

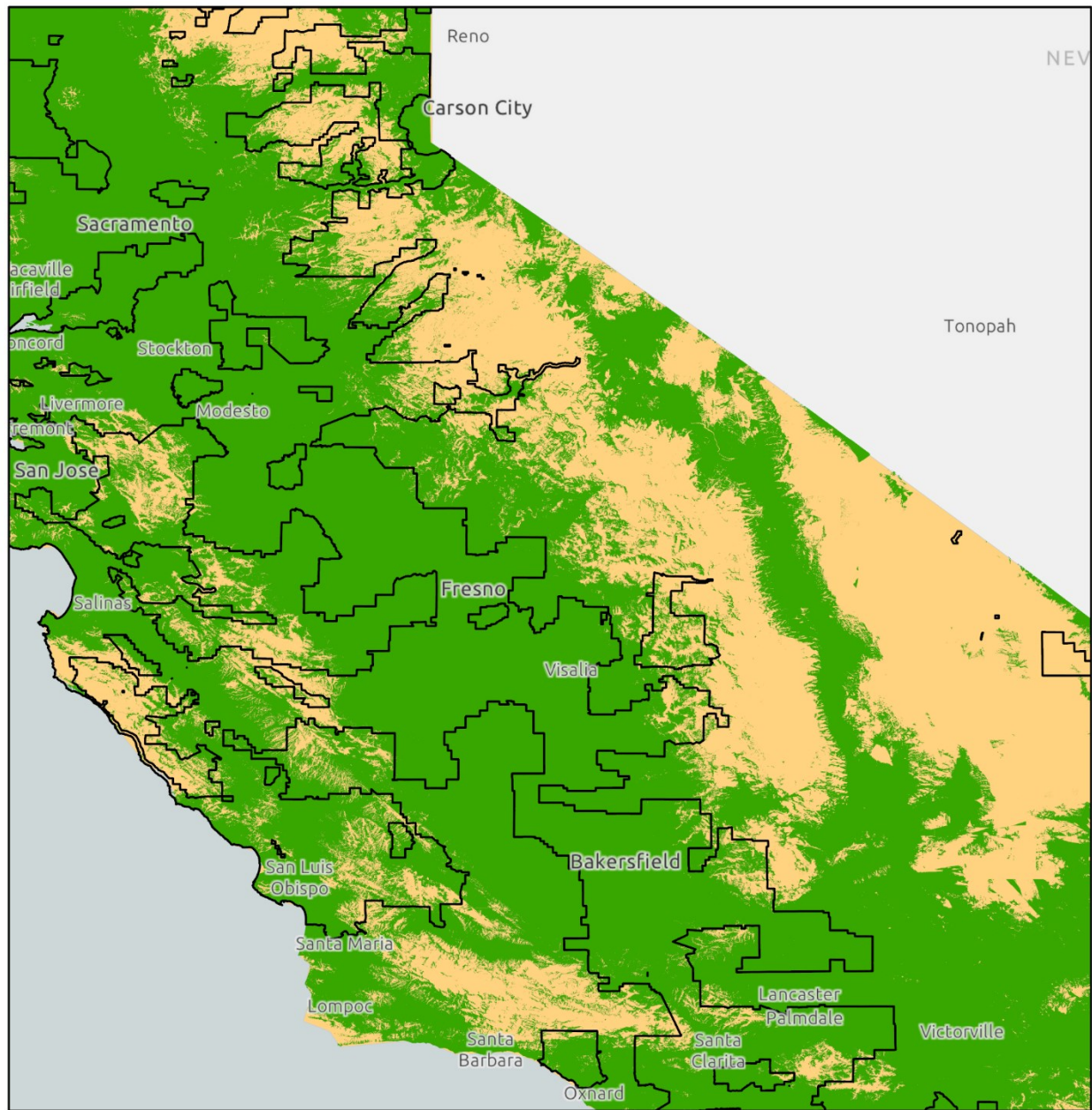
Coverage Map for AmeriMex Communications ETC Service Area

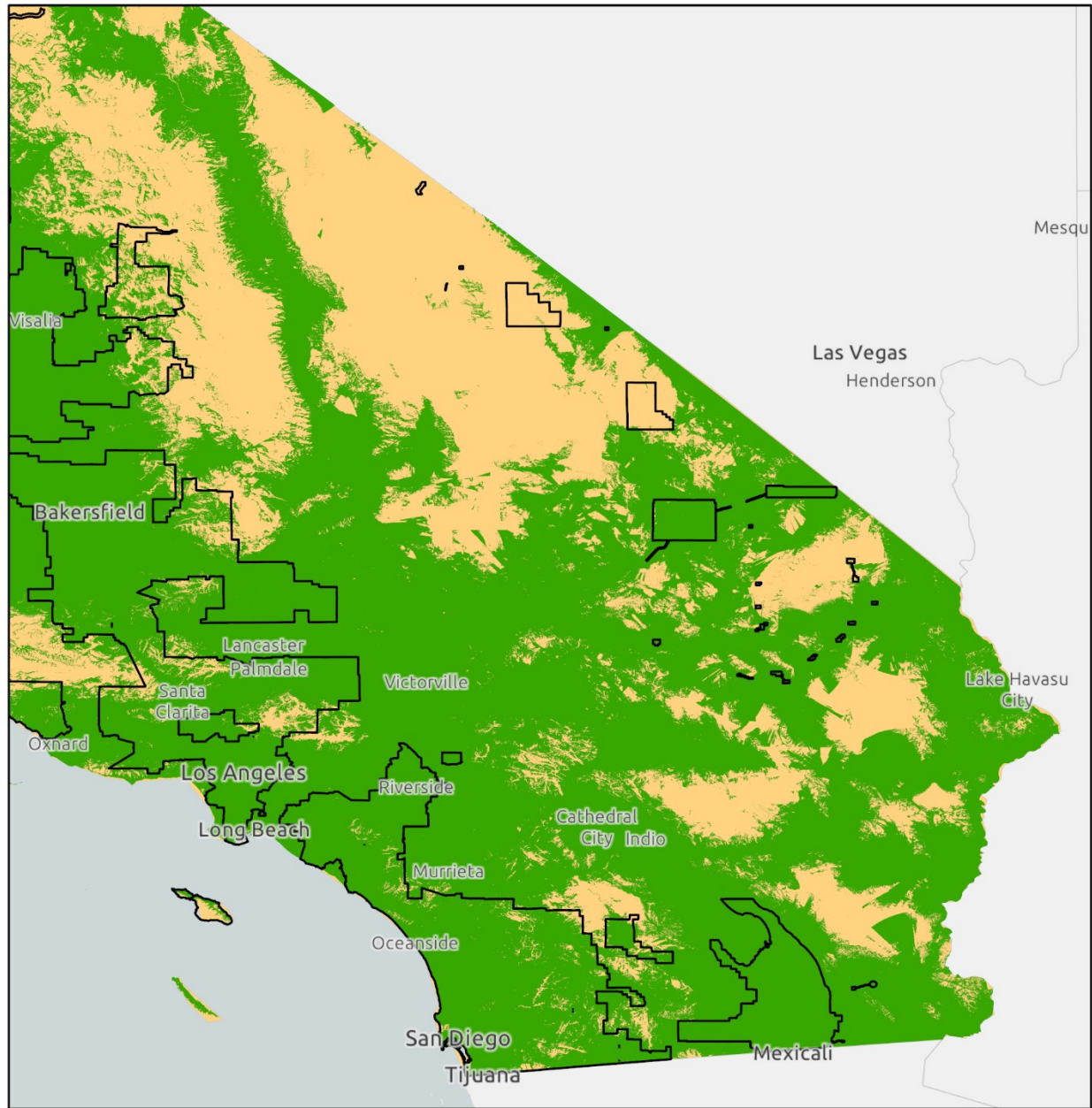

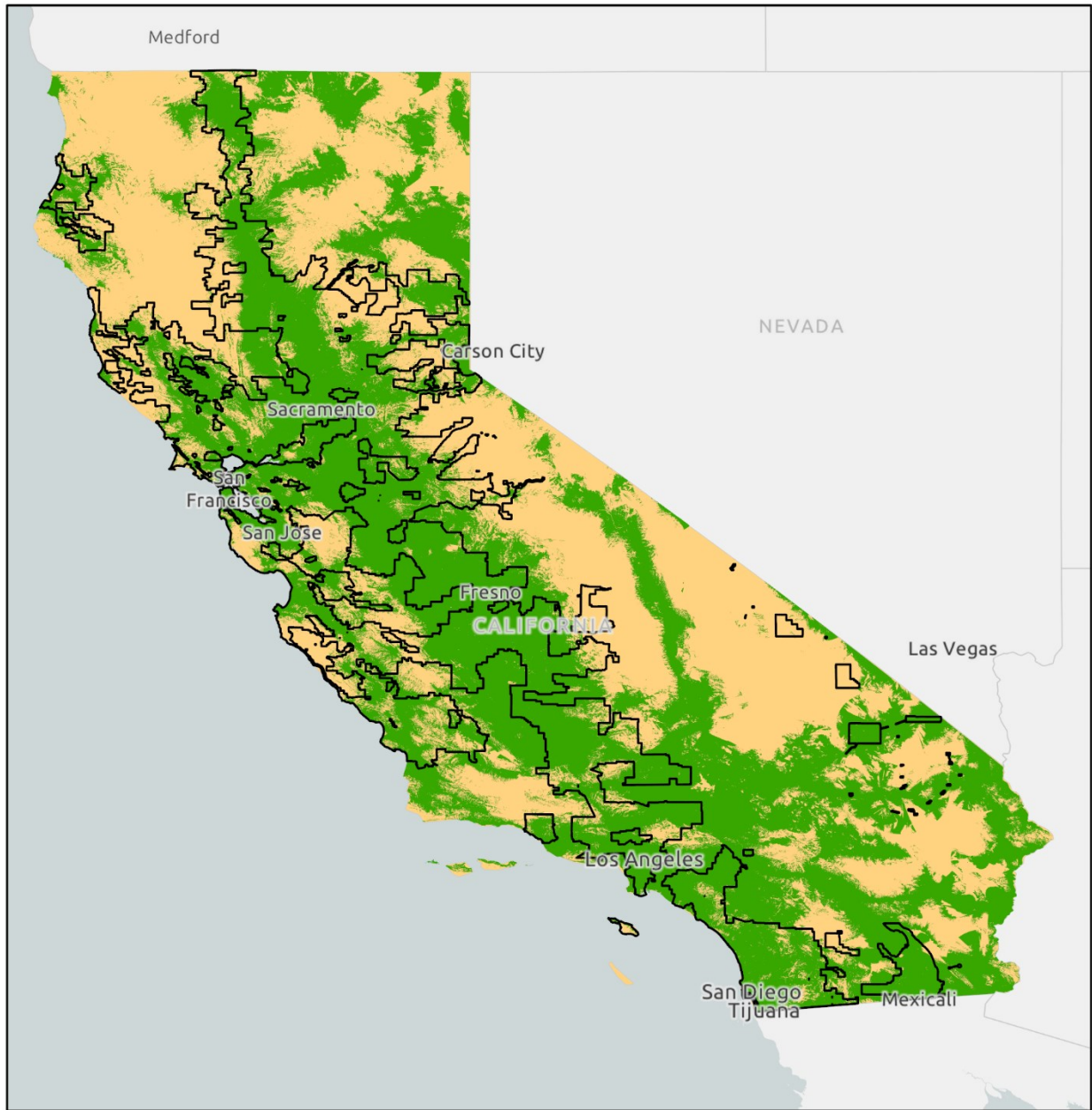

Coverage Map for Assurance Wireless USA ETC Service Area

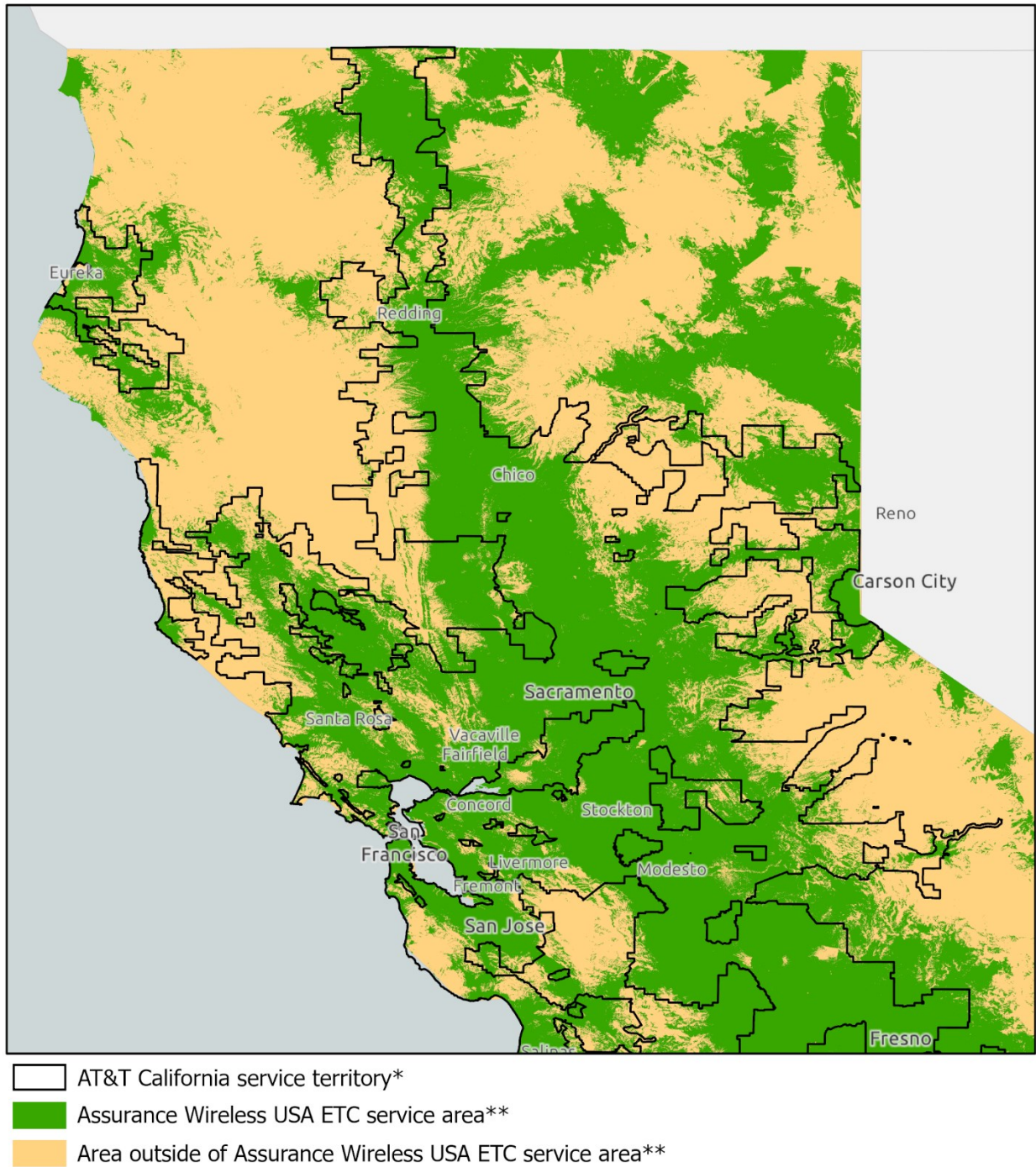

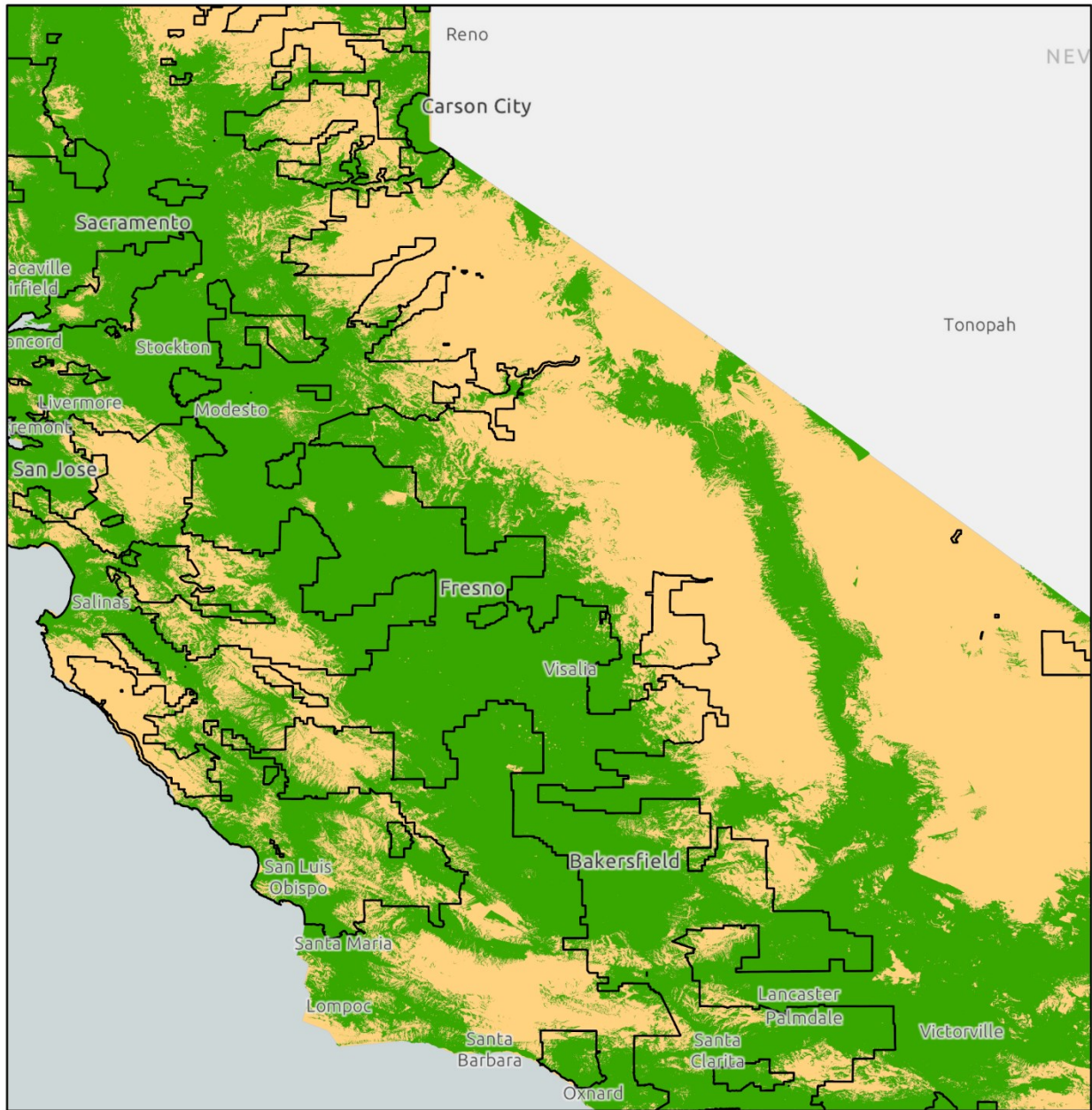
Coverage Map for Assurance Wireless USA ETC Service Area

Coverage Map for Assurance Wireless USA ETC Service Area

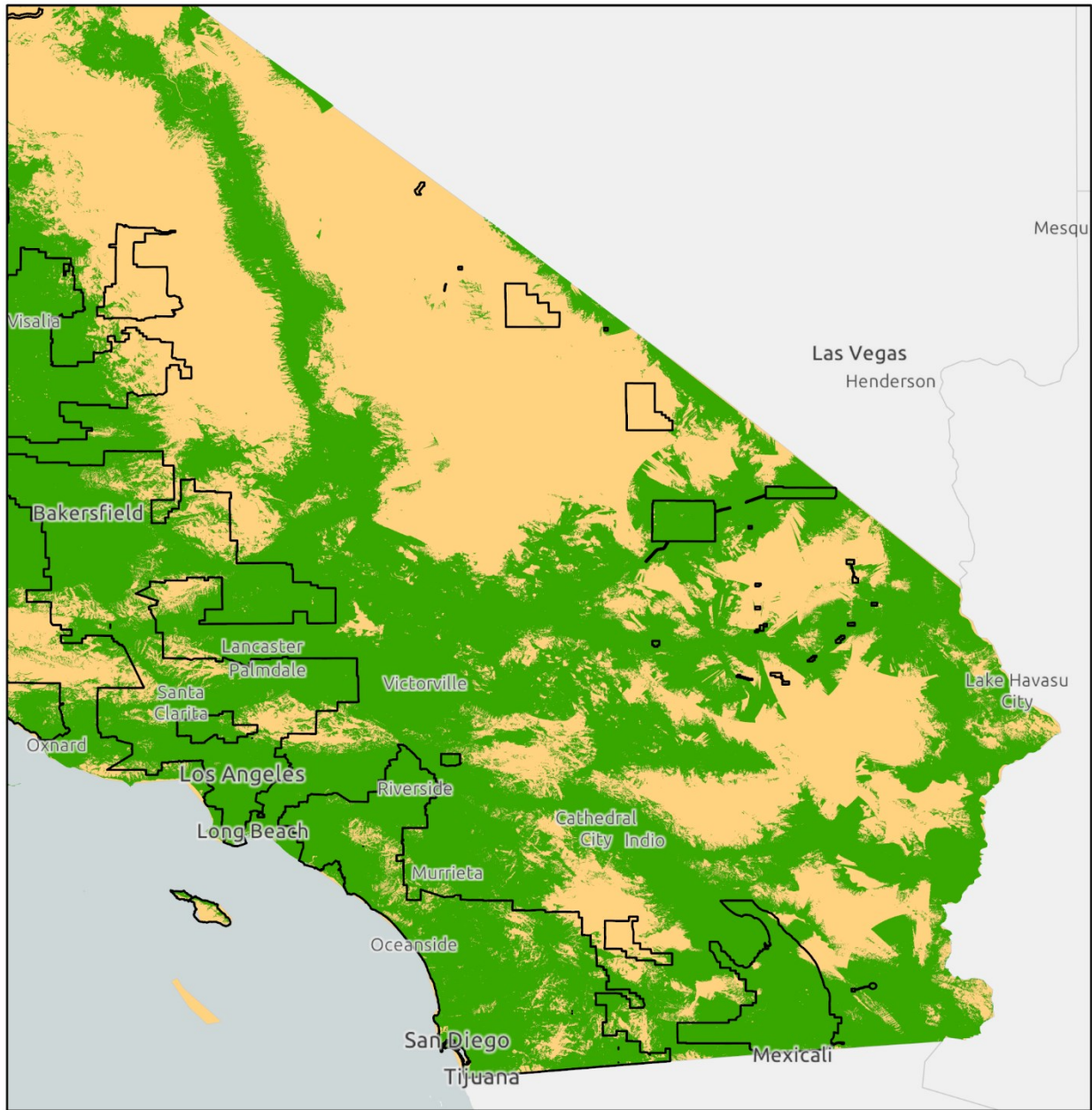

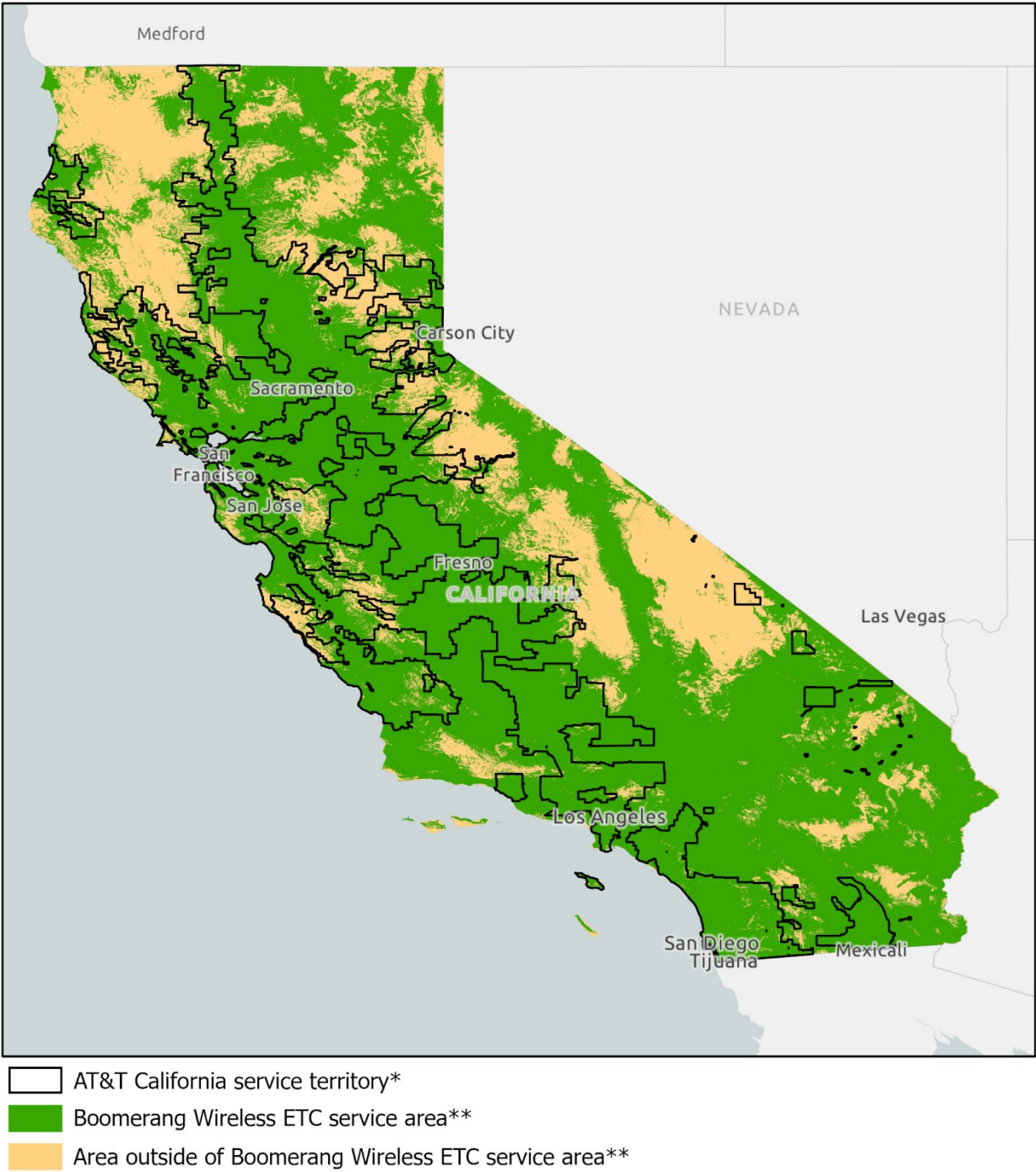

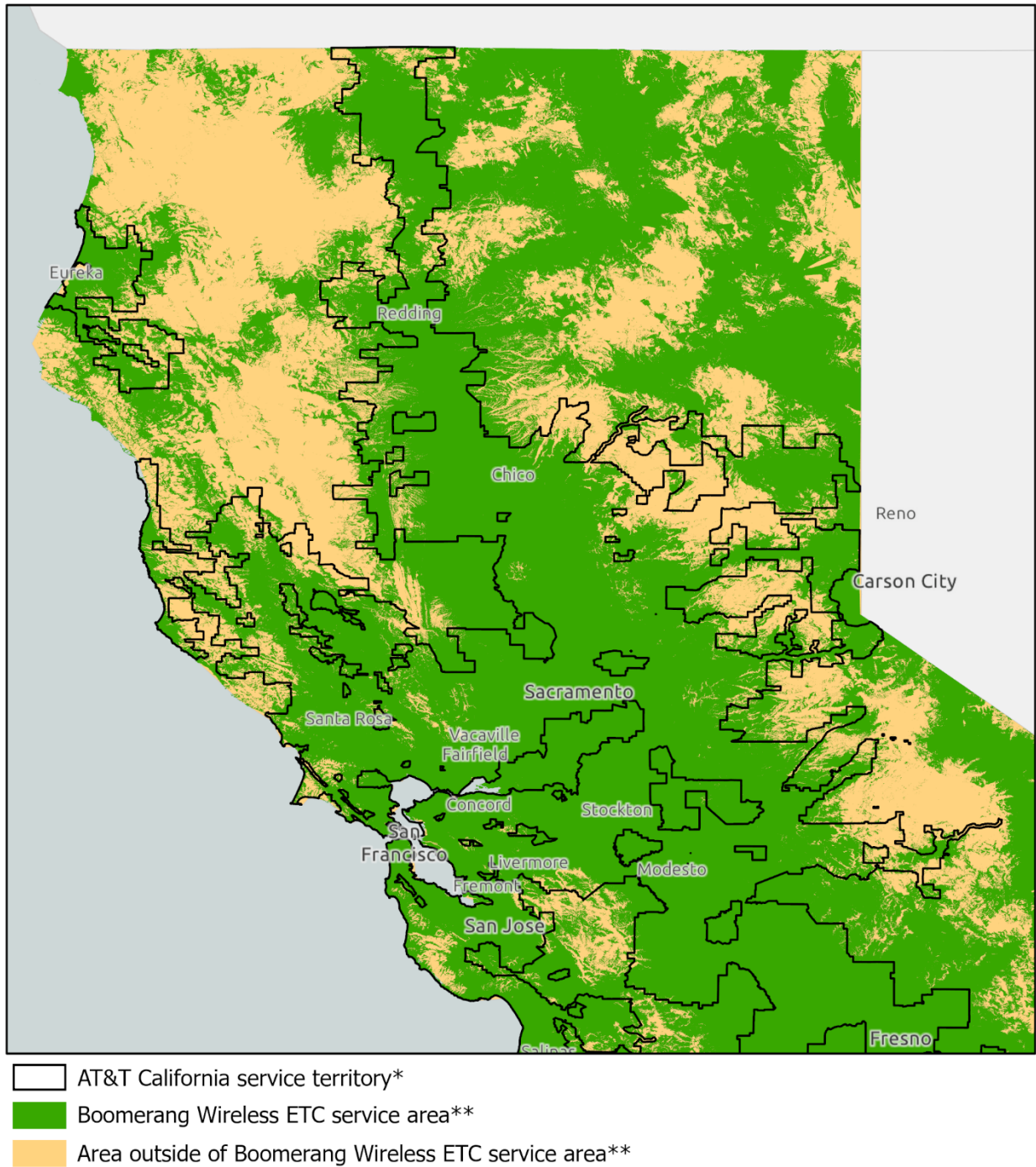
Coverage Map for Boomerang Wireless ETC Service Area

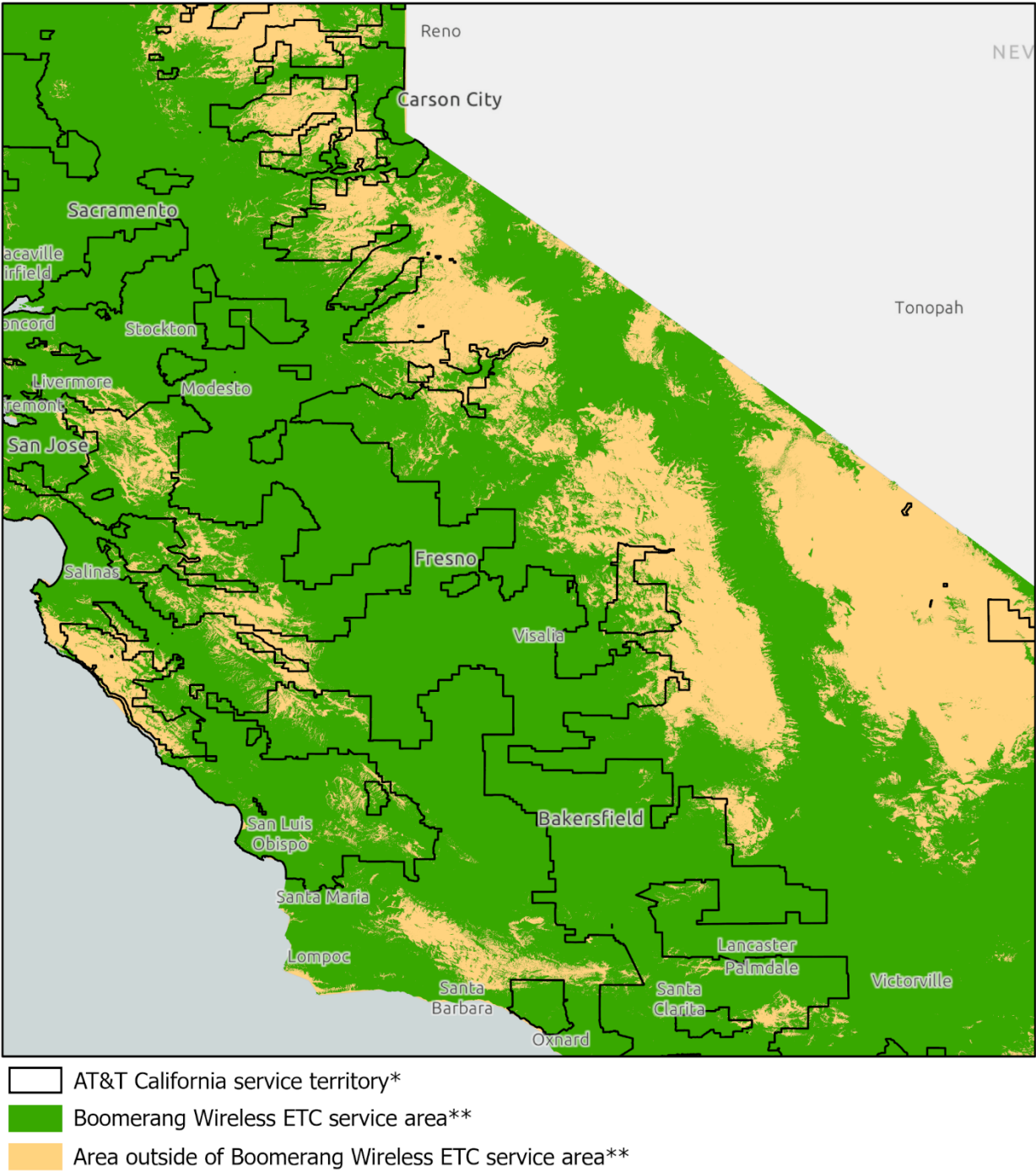
Coverage Map for Boomerang Wireless ETC Service Area




Coverage Map for Boomerang Wireless ETC Service Area



Coverage Map for Cal.net ETC Service Area

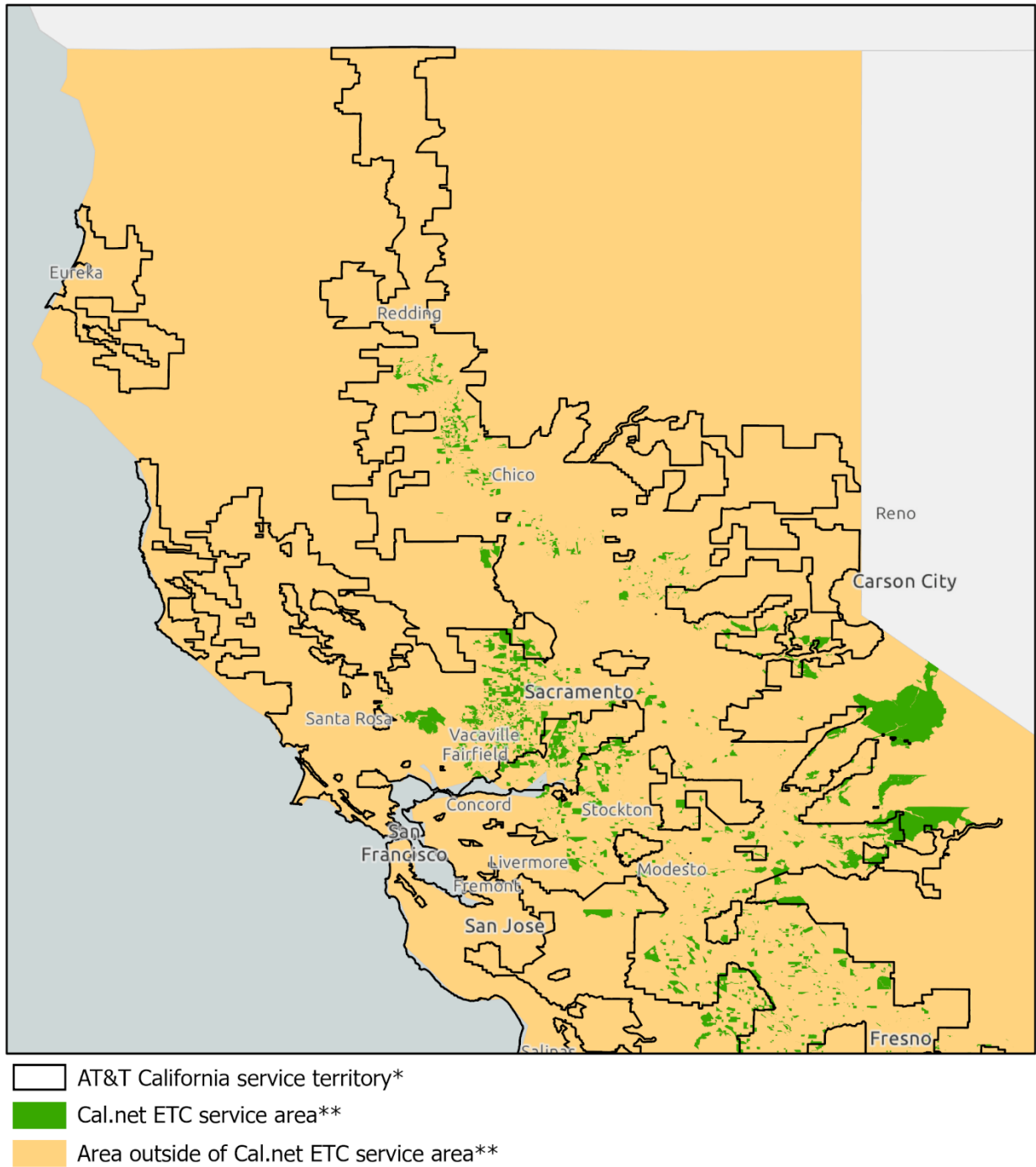

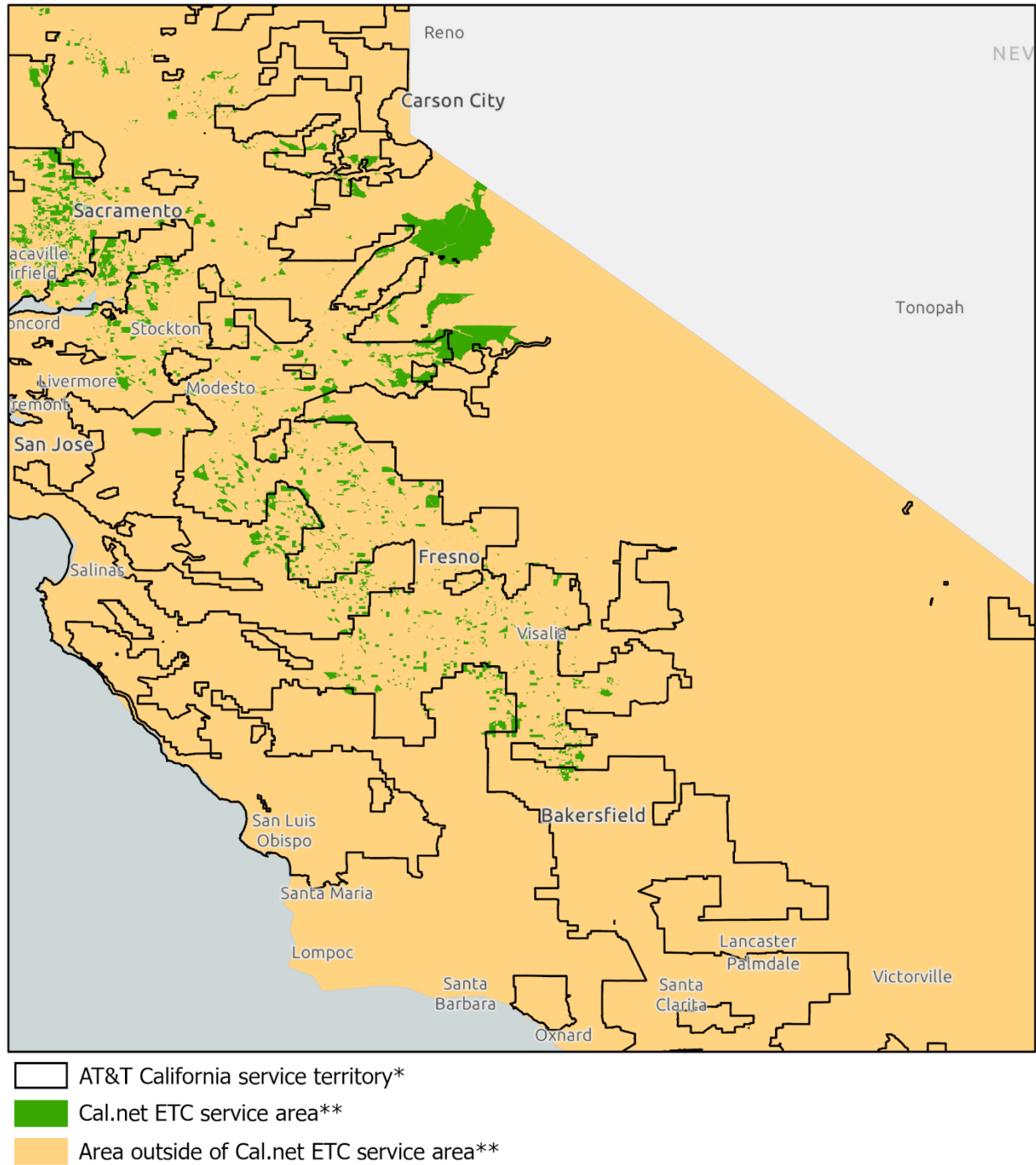
Coverage Map for Cal.net ETC Service Area

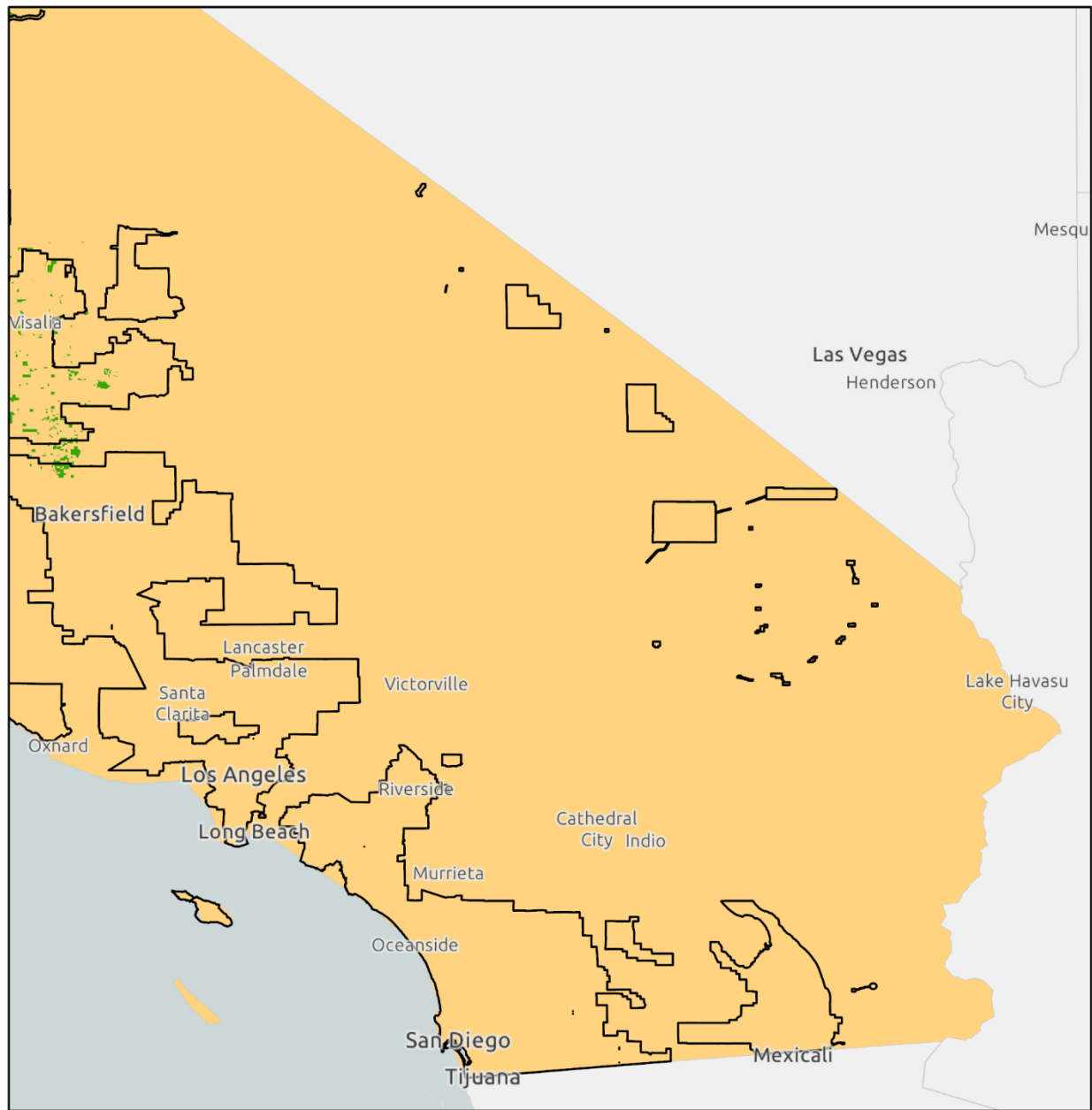
Coverage Map for Cal.net ETC Service Area



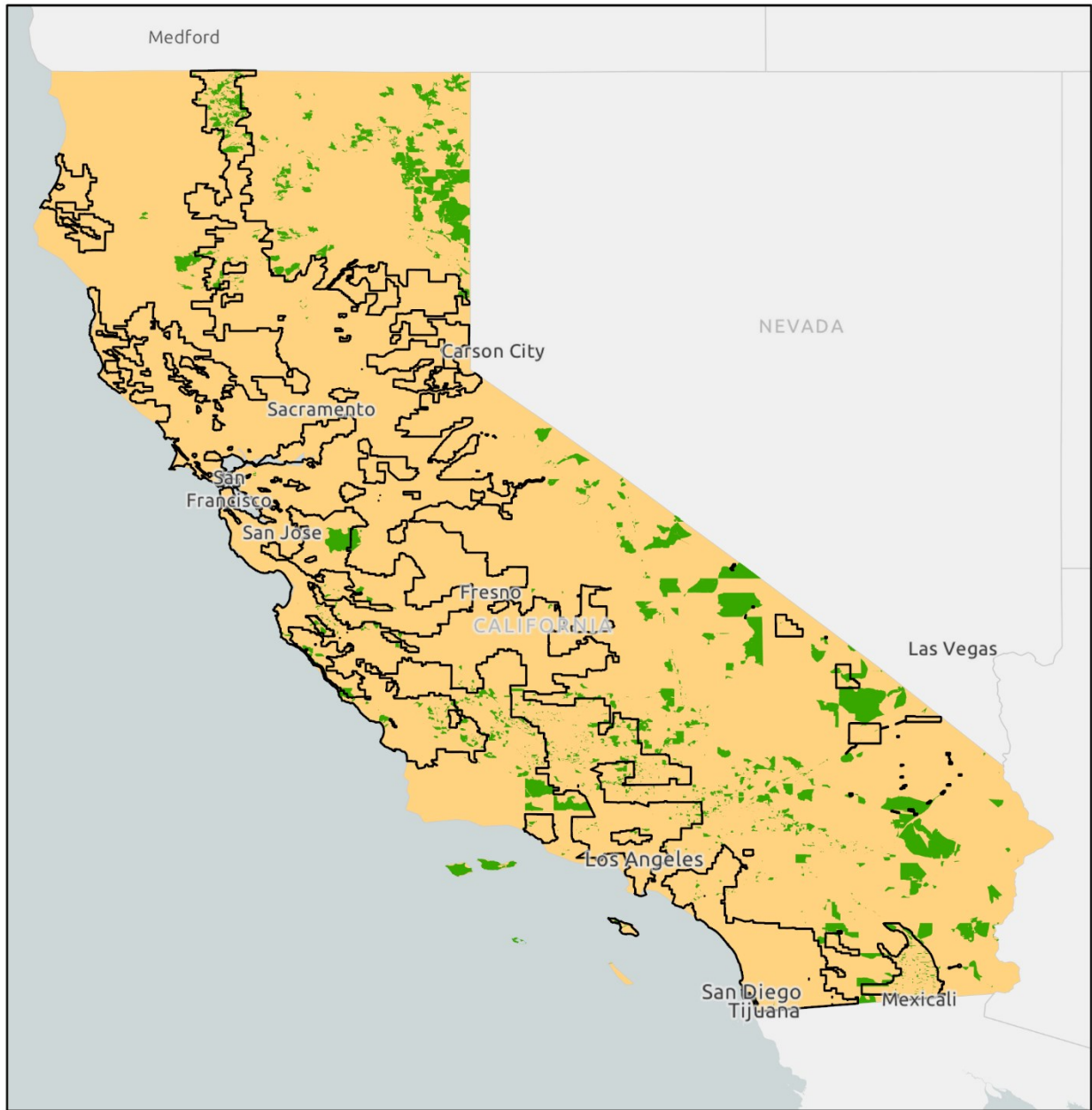

Coverage Map for California Internet ETC Service Area

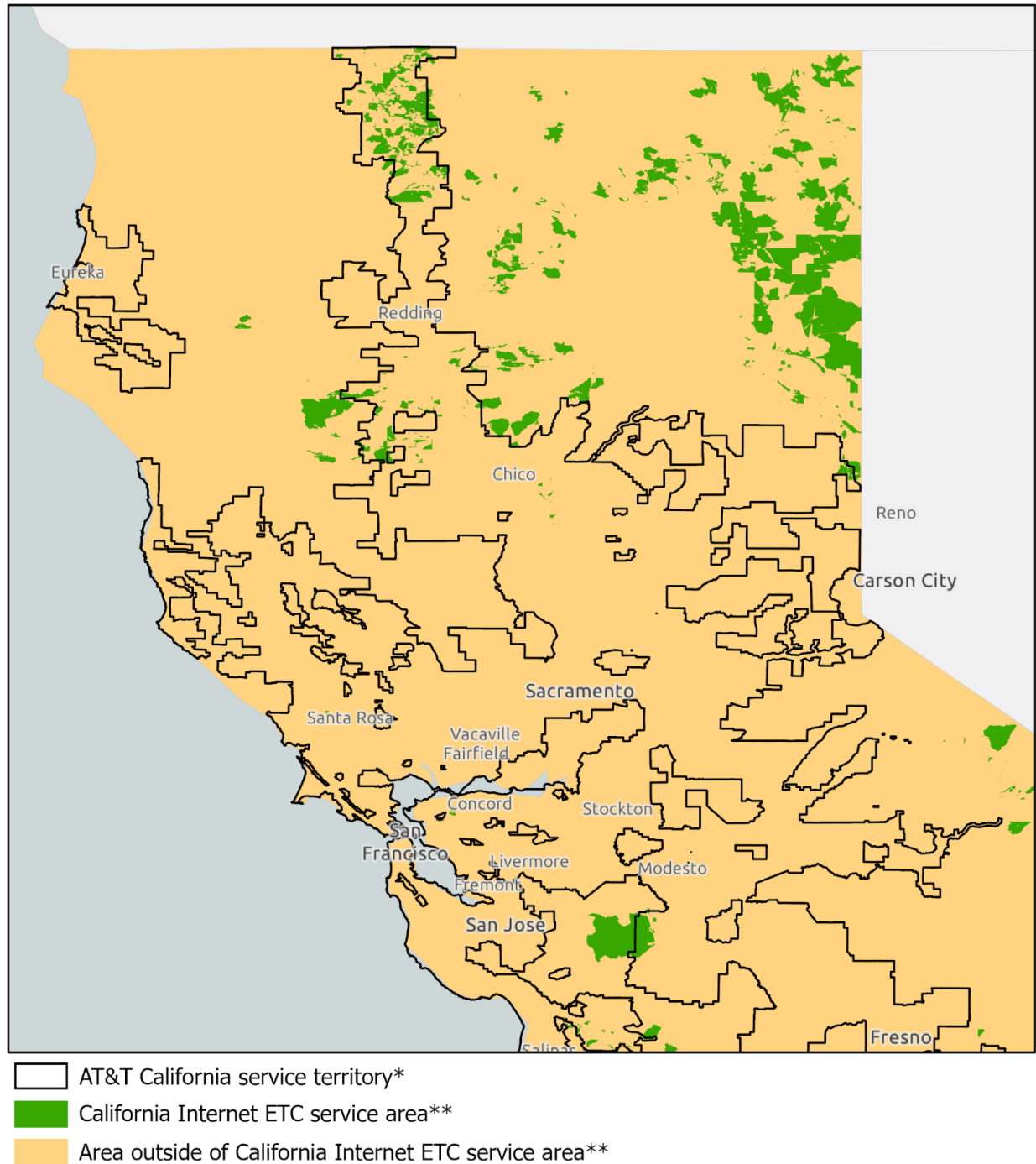

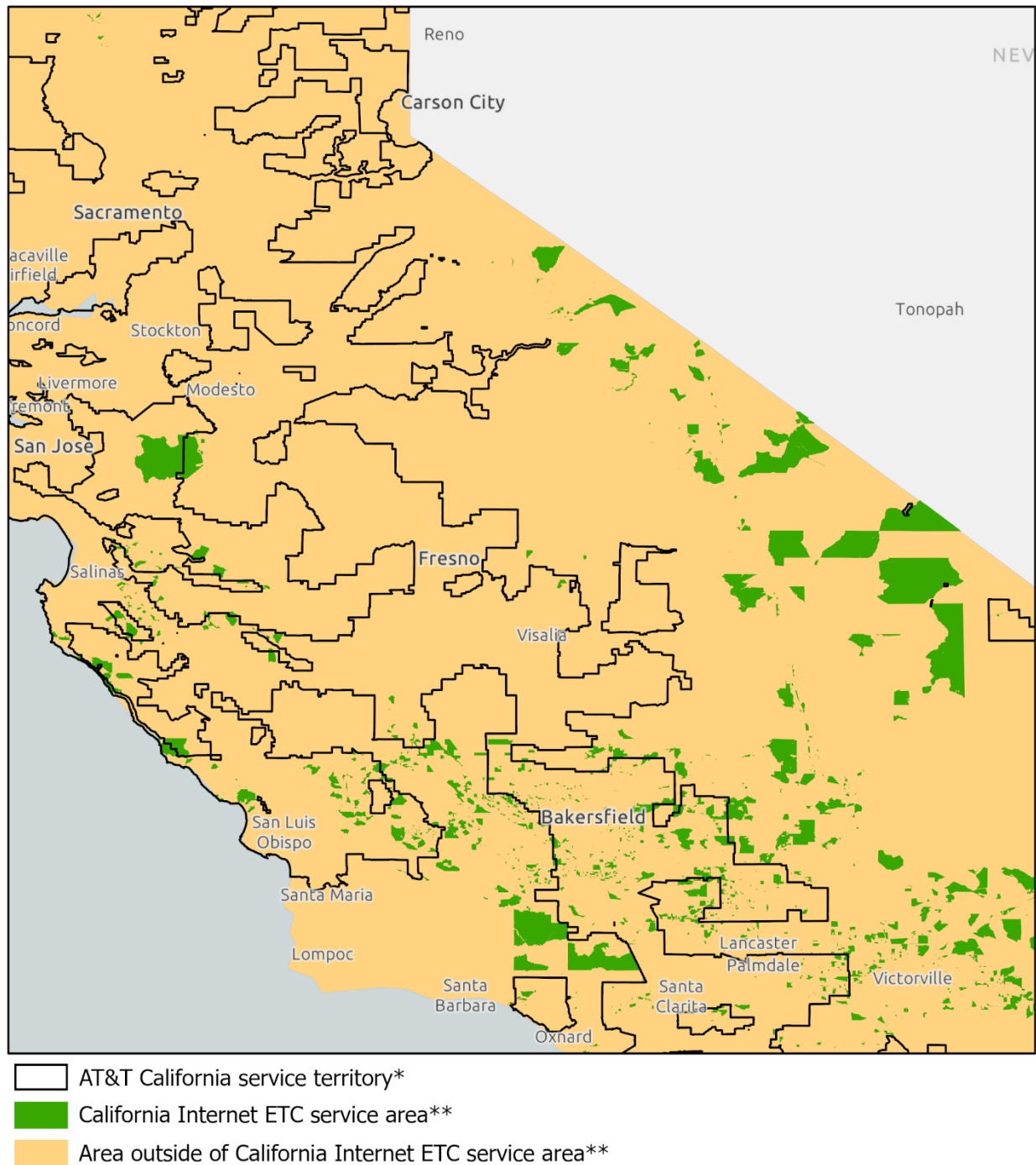
Coverage Map for California Internet ETC Service Area

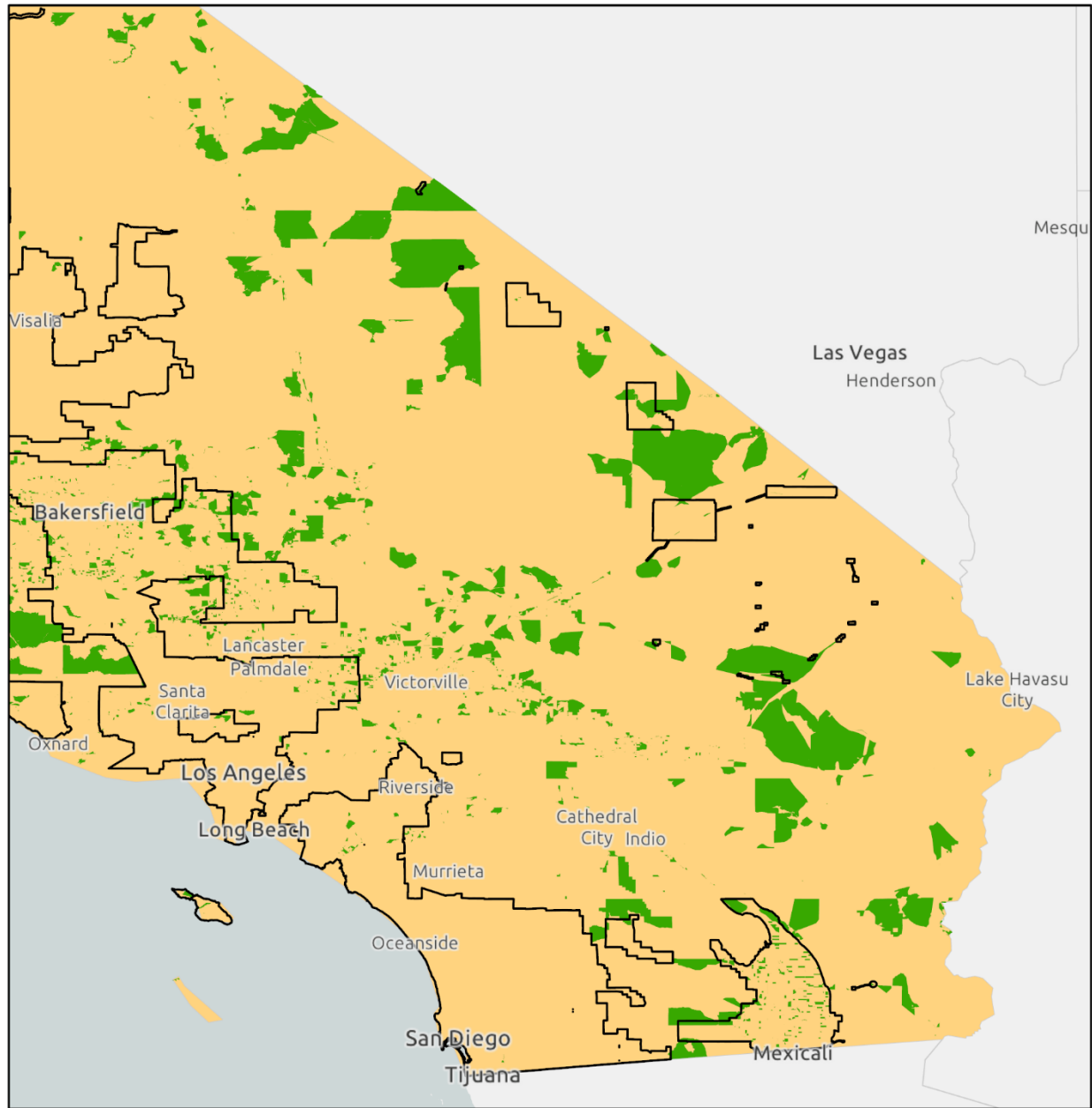
Coverage Map for California Internet ETC Service Area



Coverage Map for Connect To Communications ETC Service Area

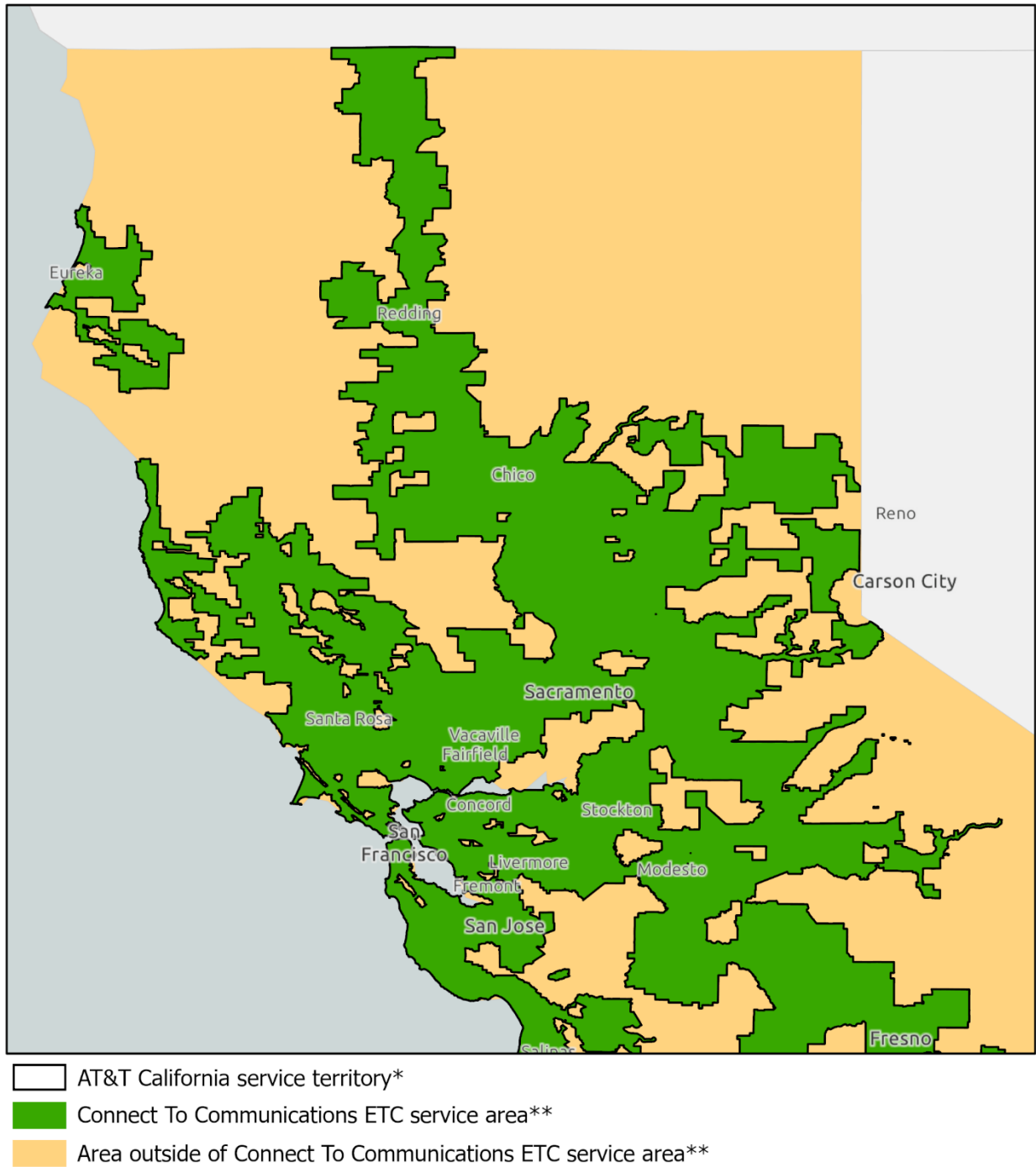

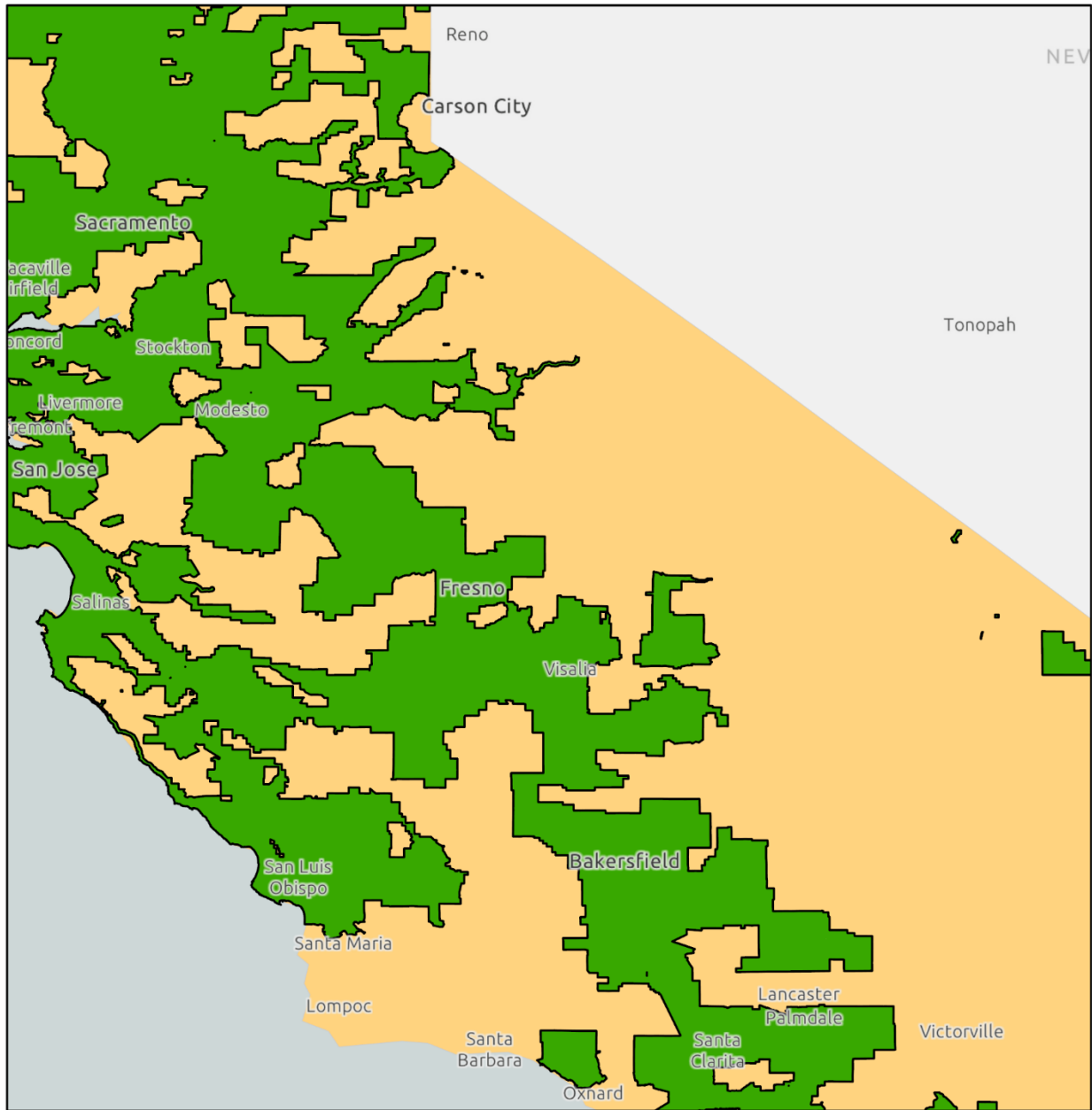
Coverage Map for Connect To Communications ETC Service Area



Coverage Map for Connect To Communications ETC Service Area

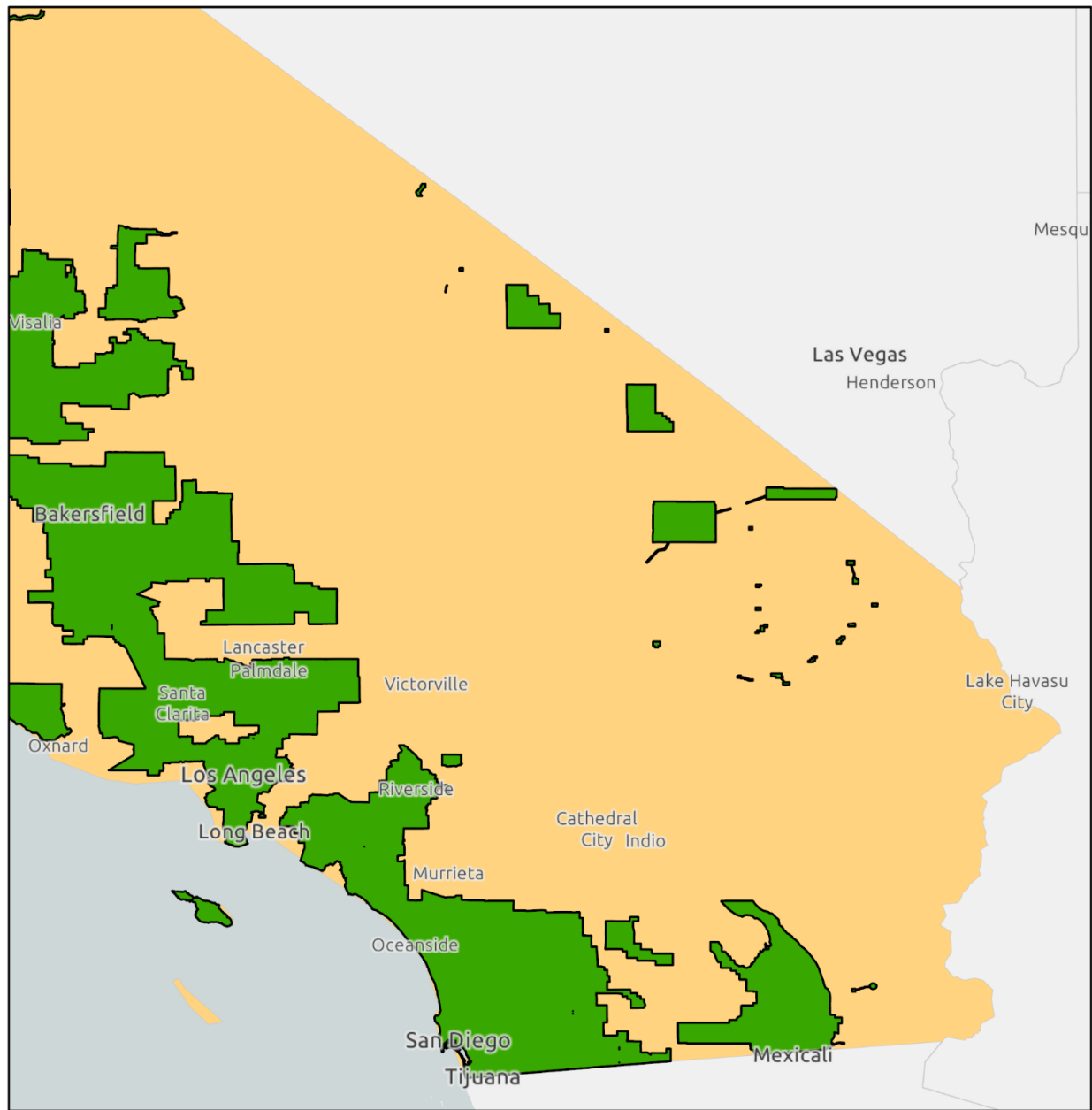

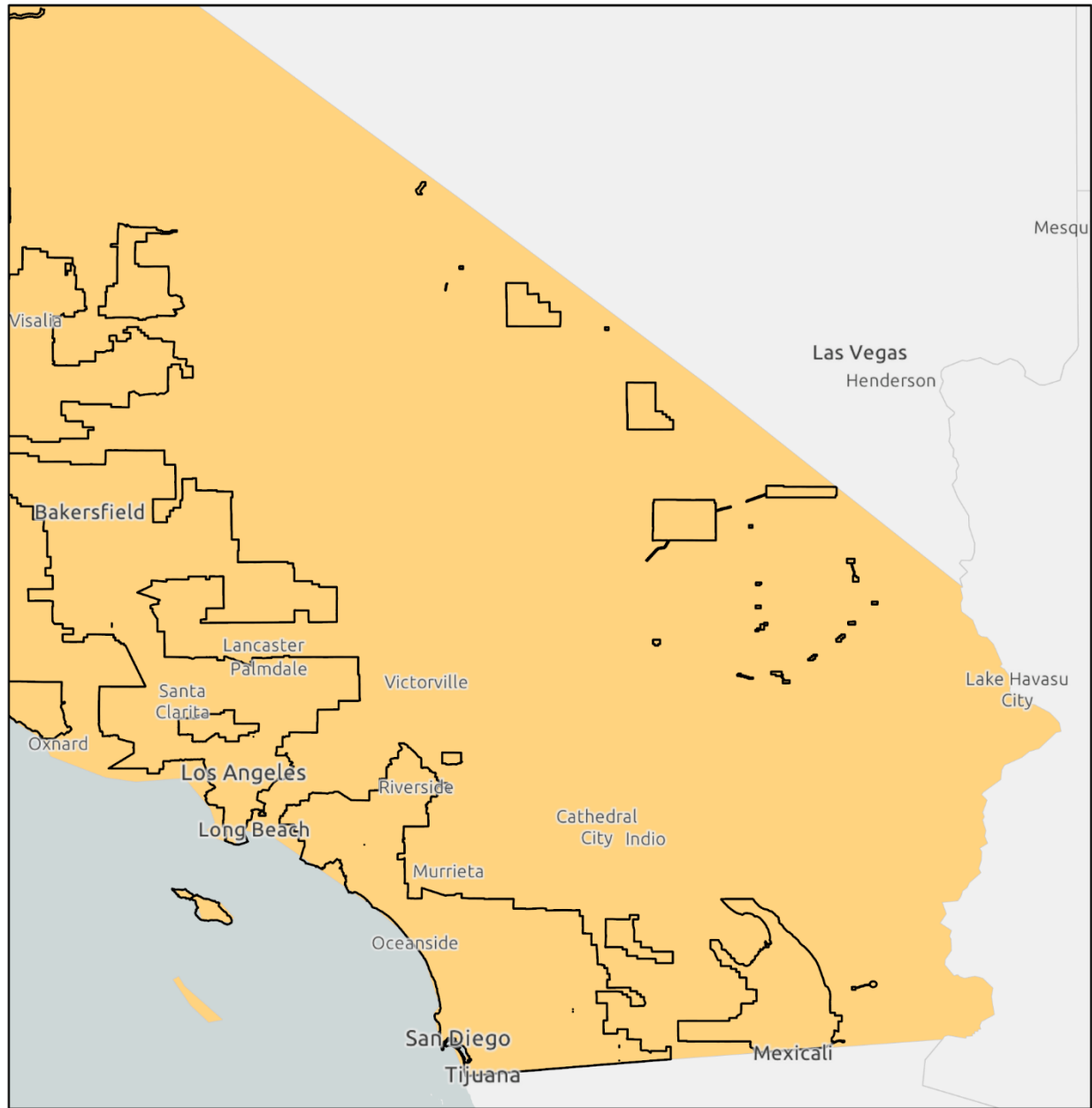

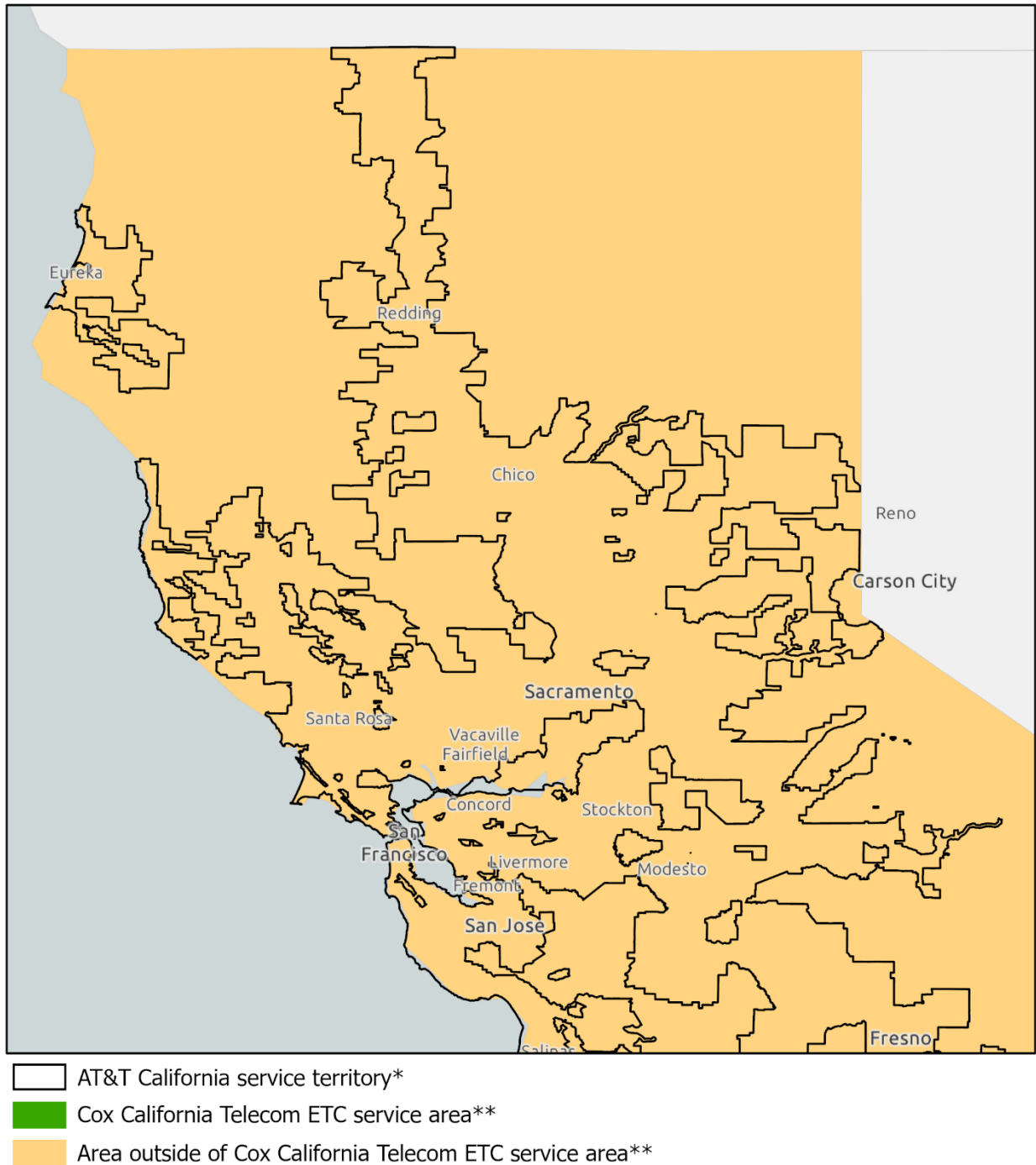

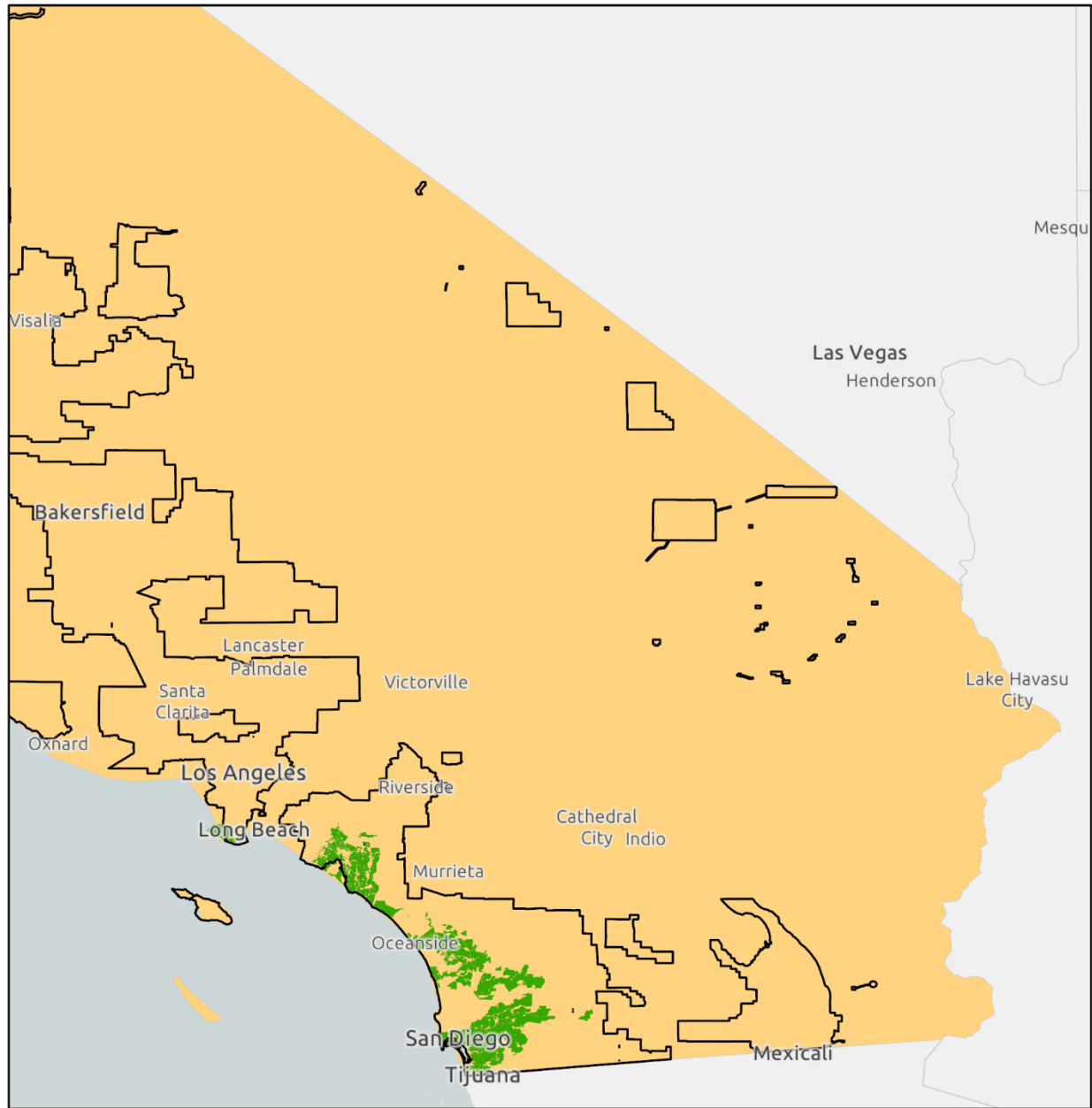

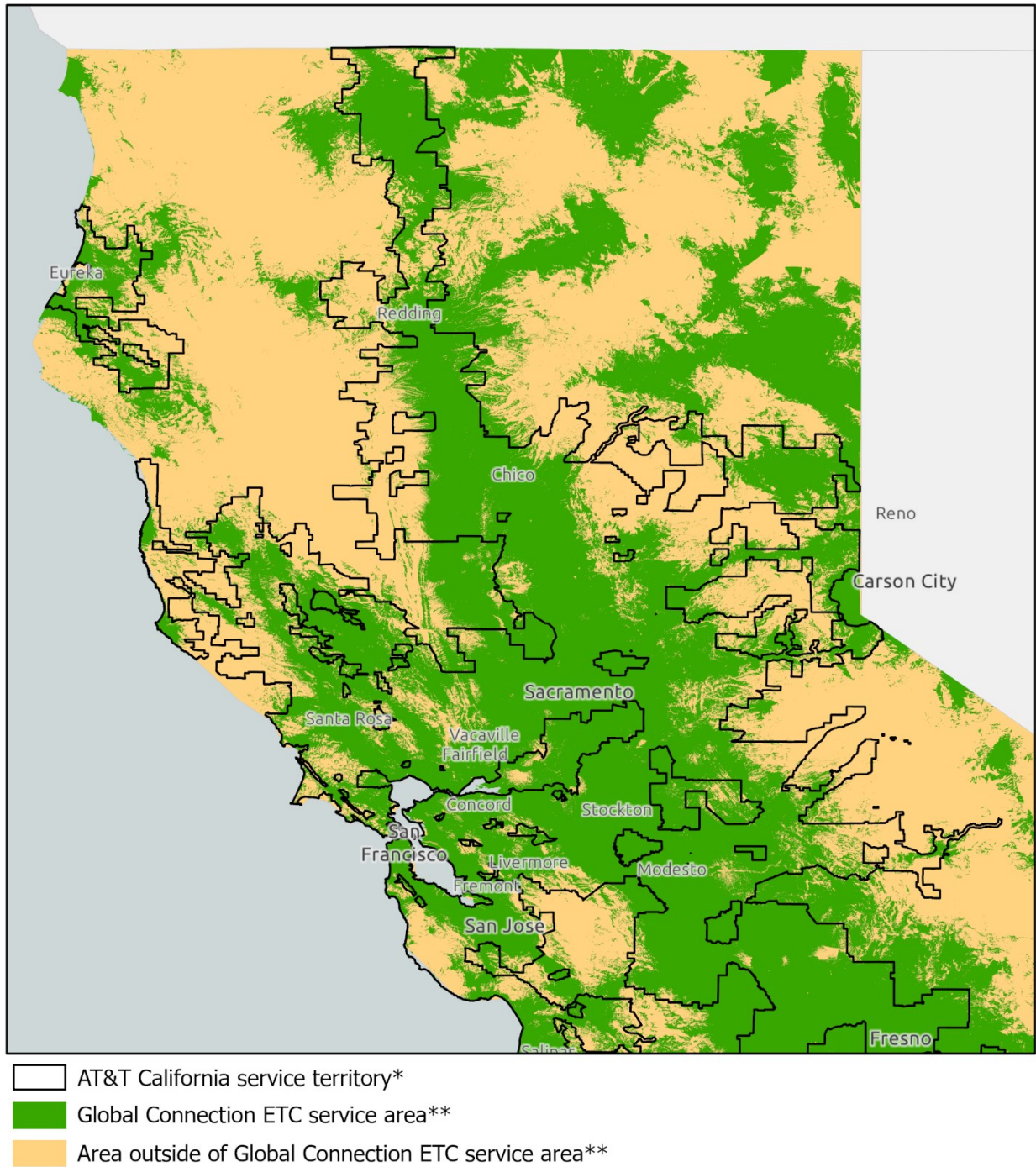
Coverage Map for Global Connection ETC Service Area

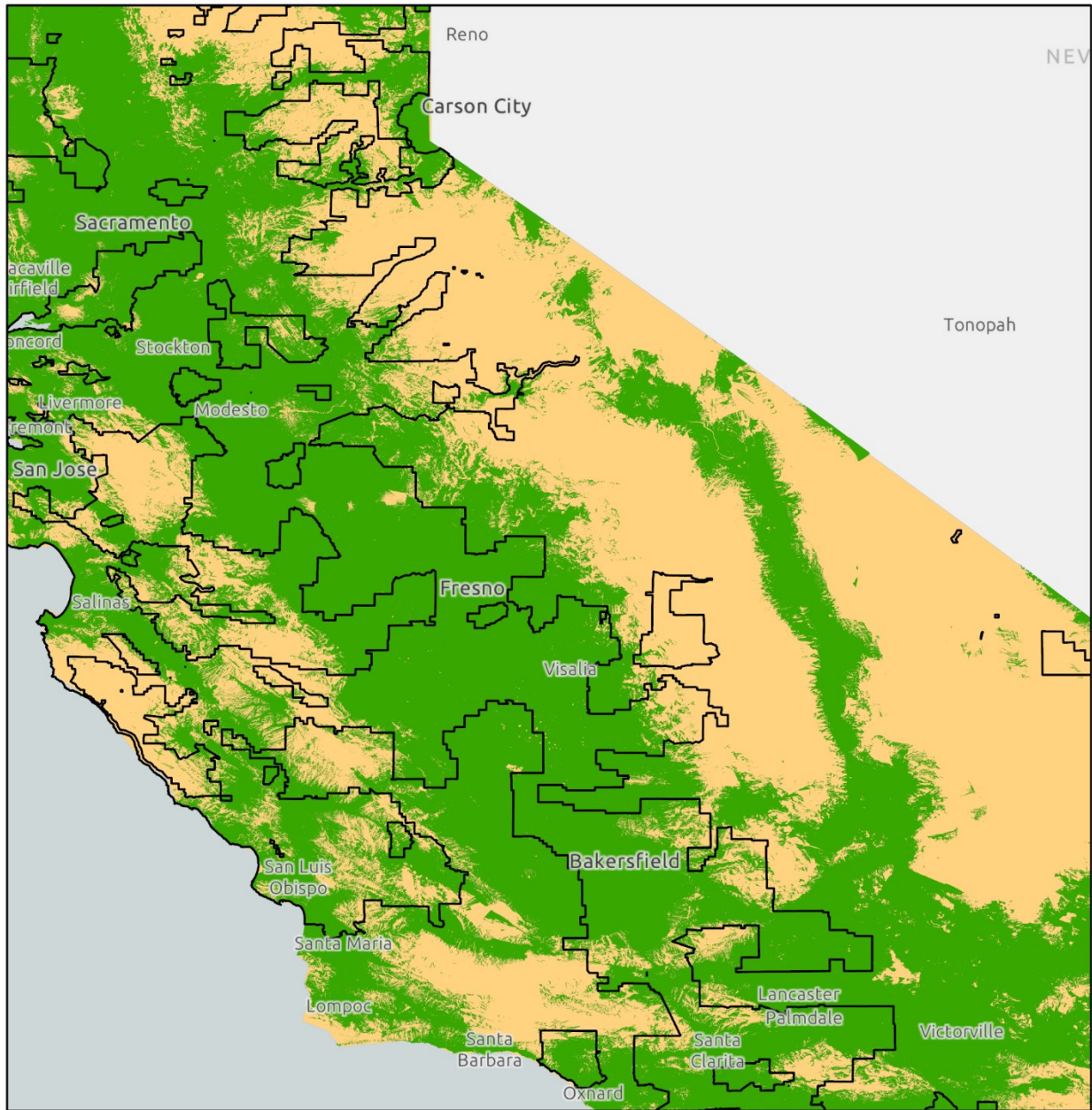
Coverage Map for Global Connection ETC Service Area





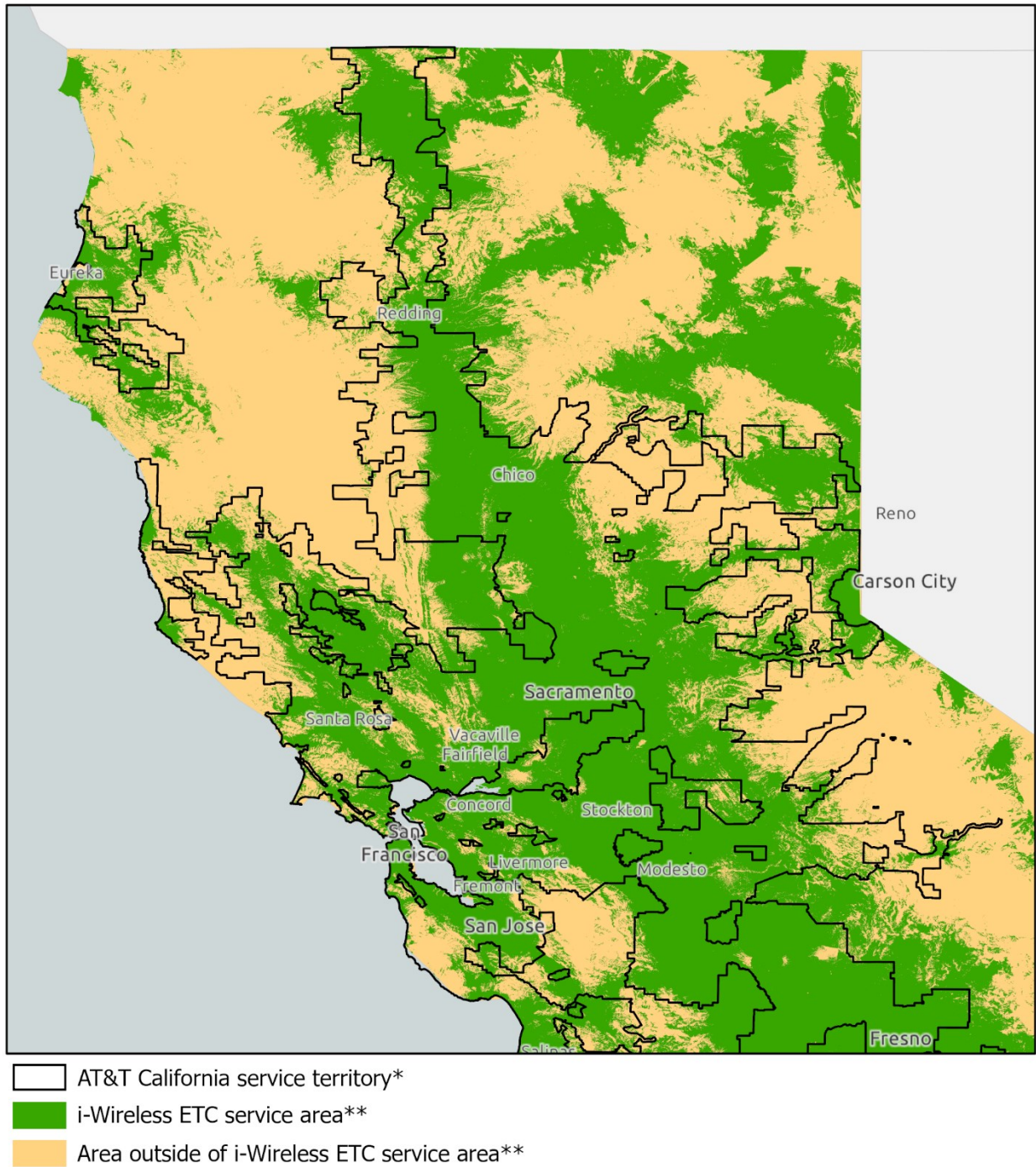
Coverage Map for i-Wireless ETC Service Area

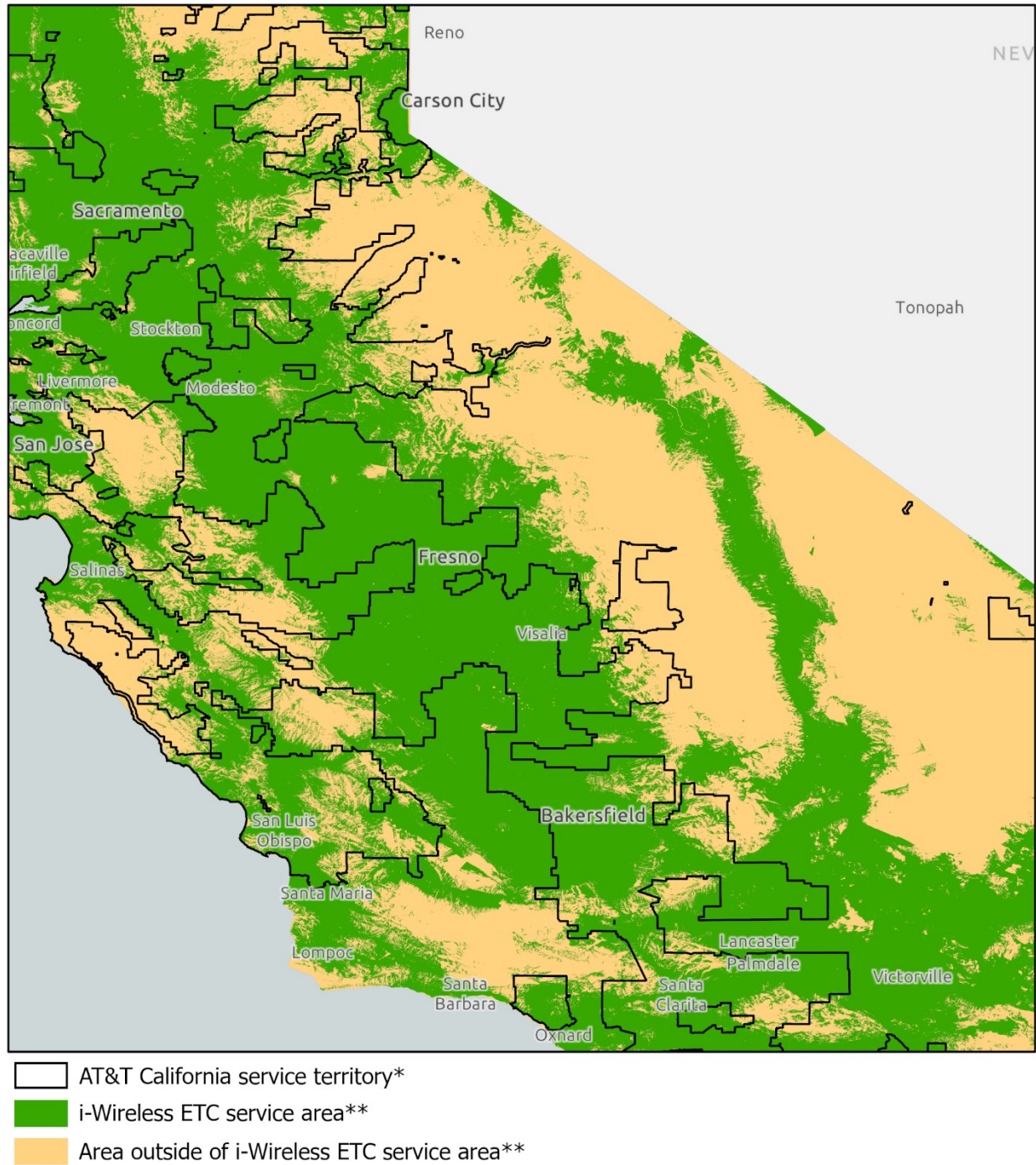
Coverage Map for i-Wireless ETC Service Area

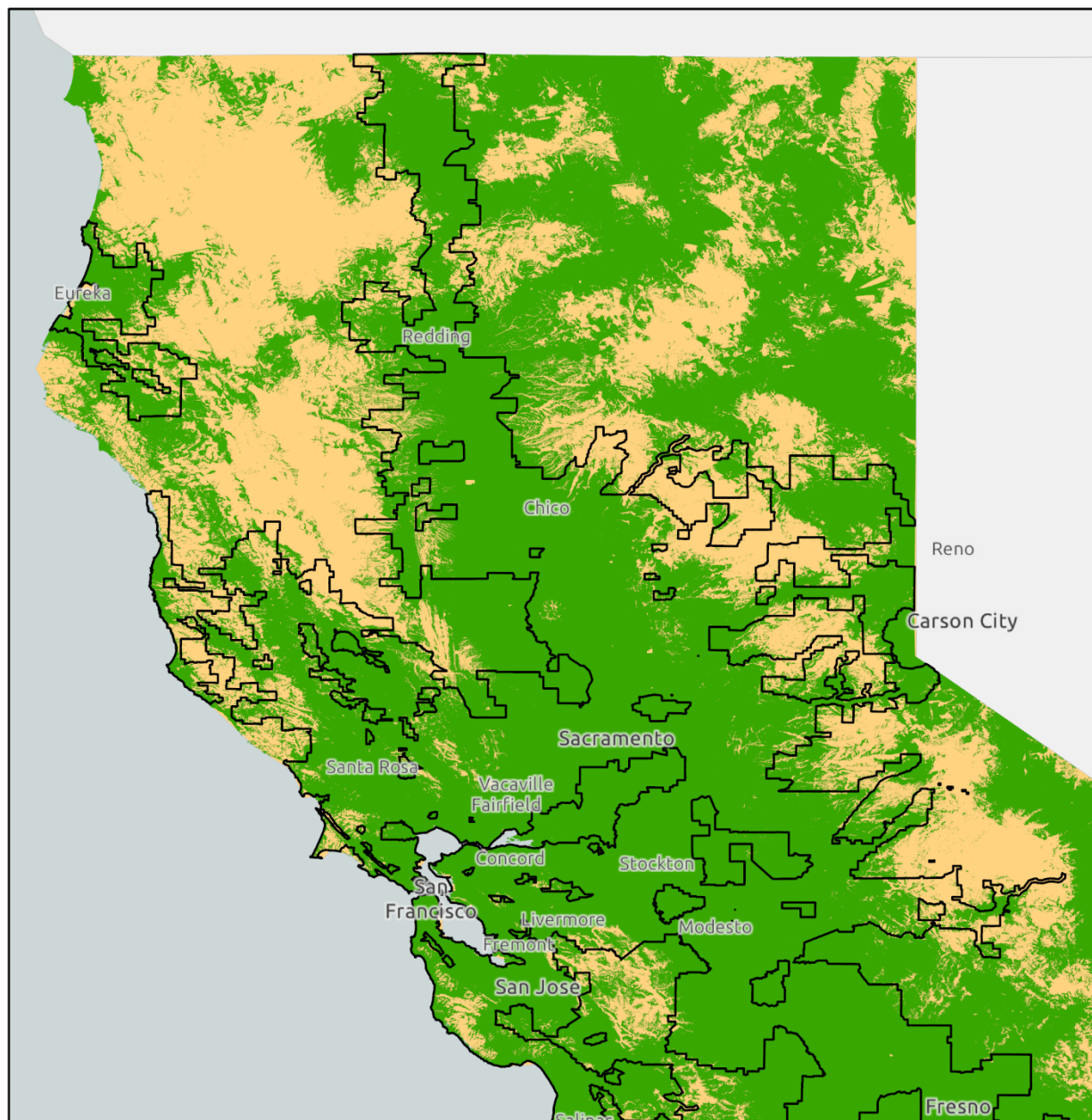
Coverage Map for IM Telecom ETC Service Area

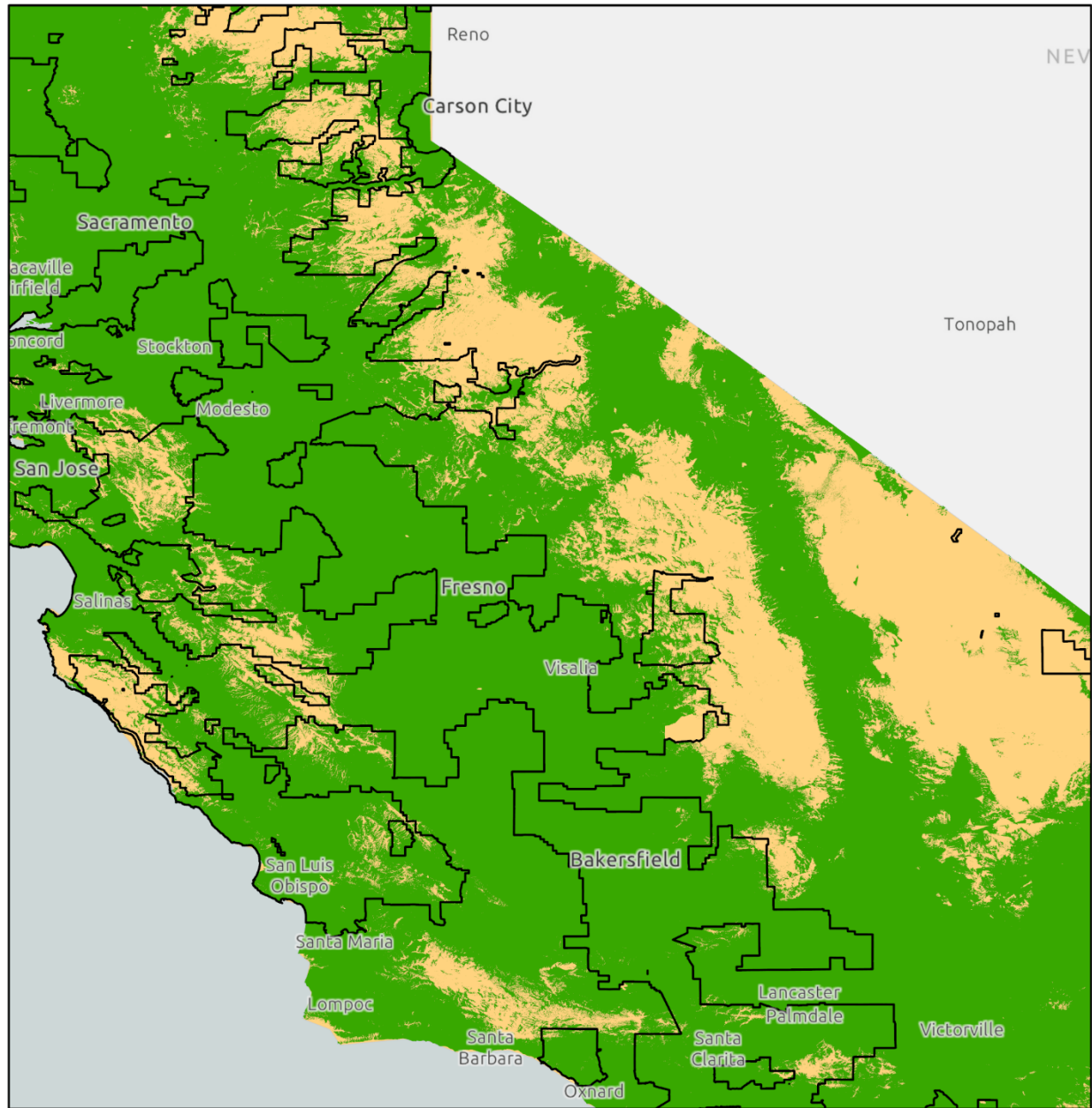

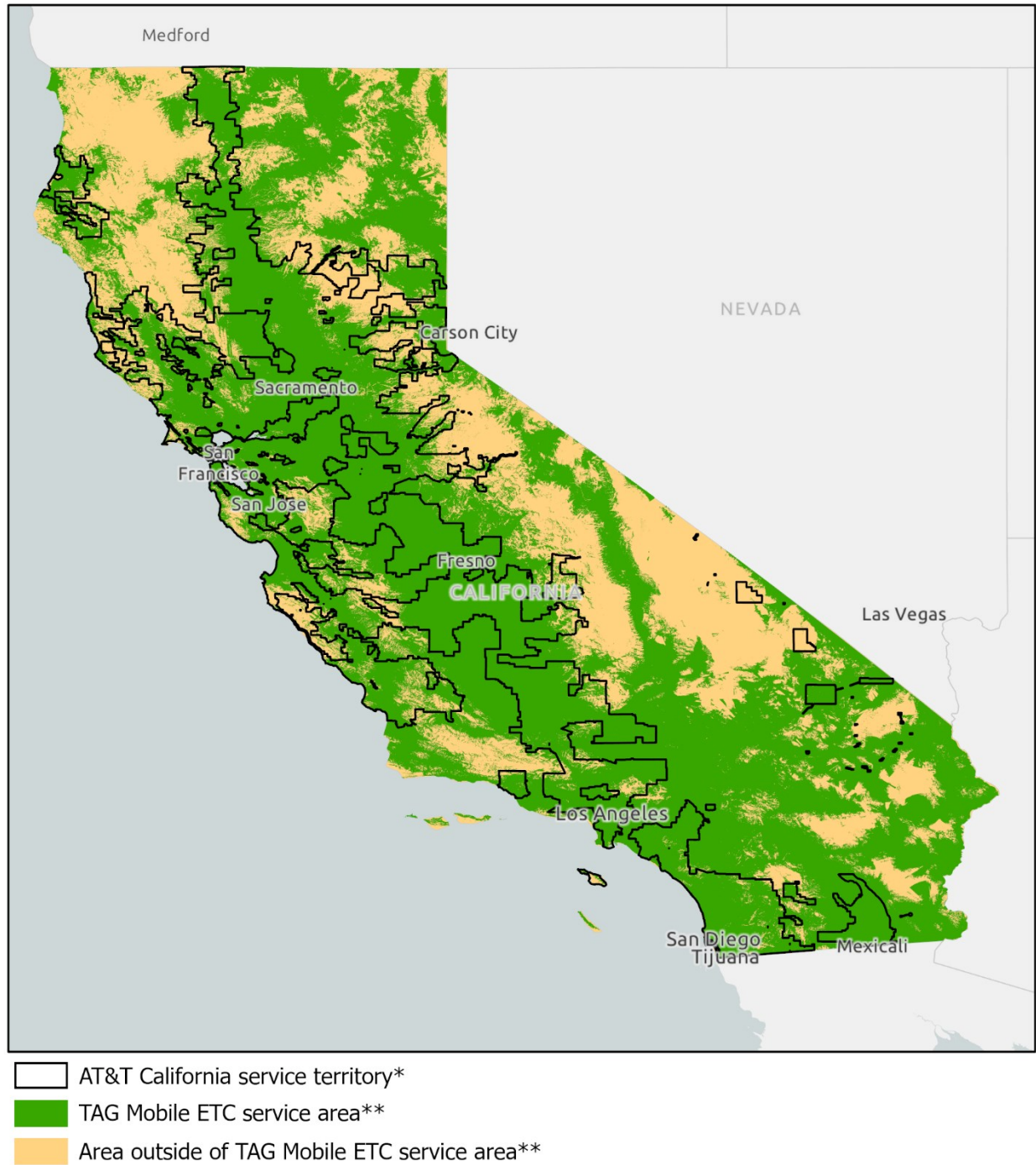

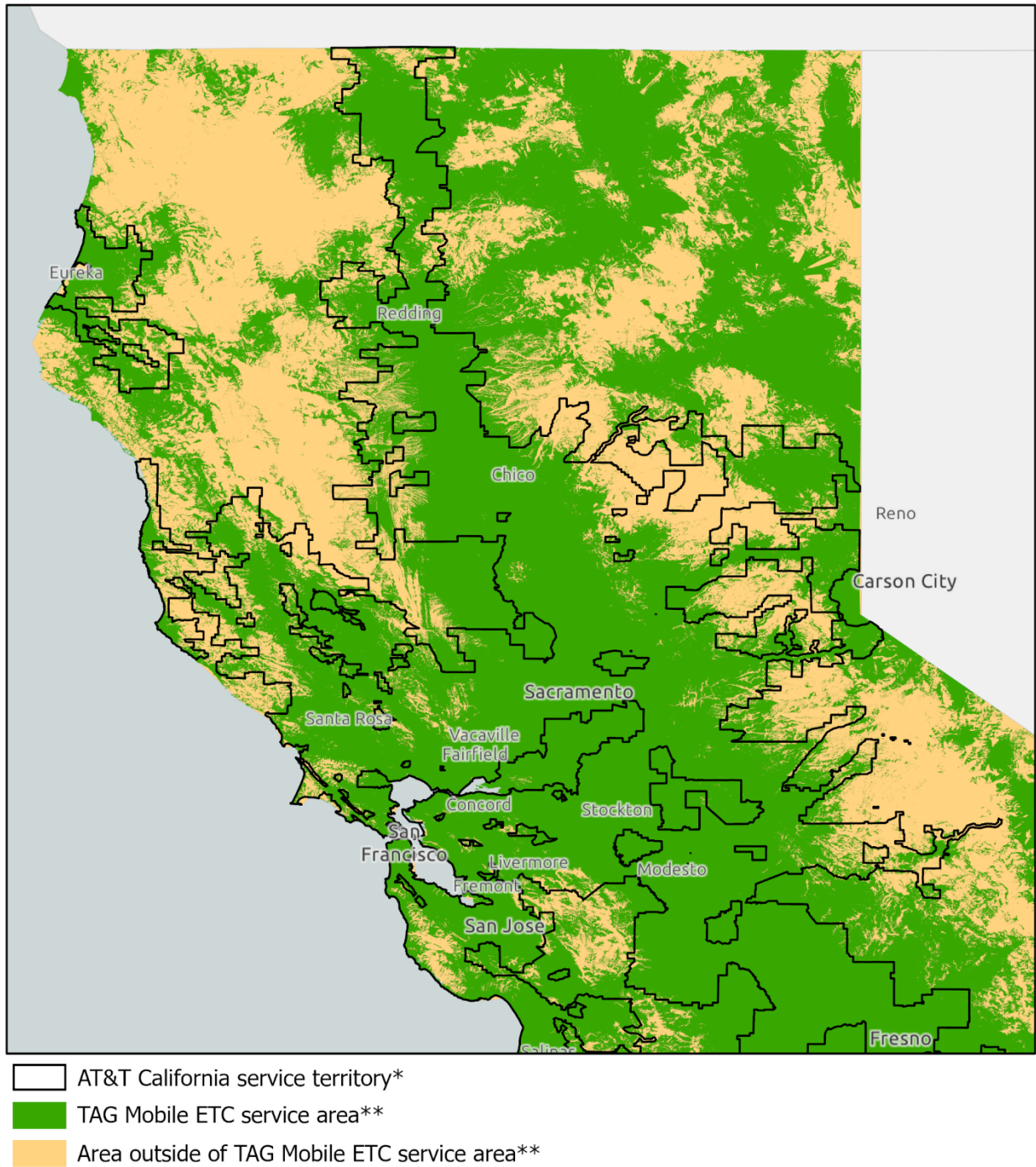
Coverage Map for TAG Mobile ETC Service Area

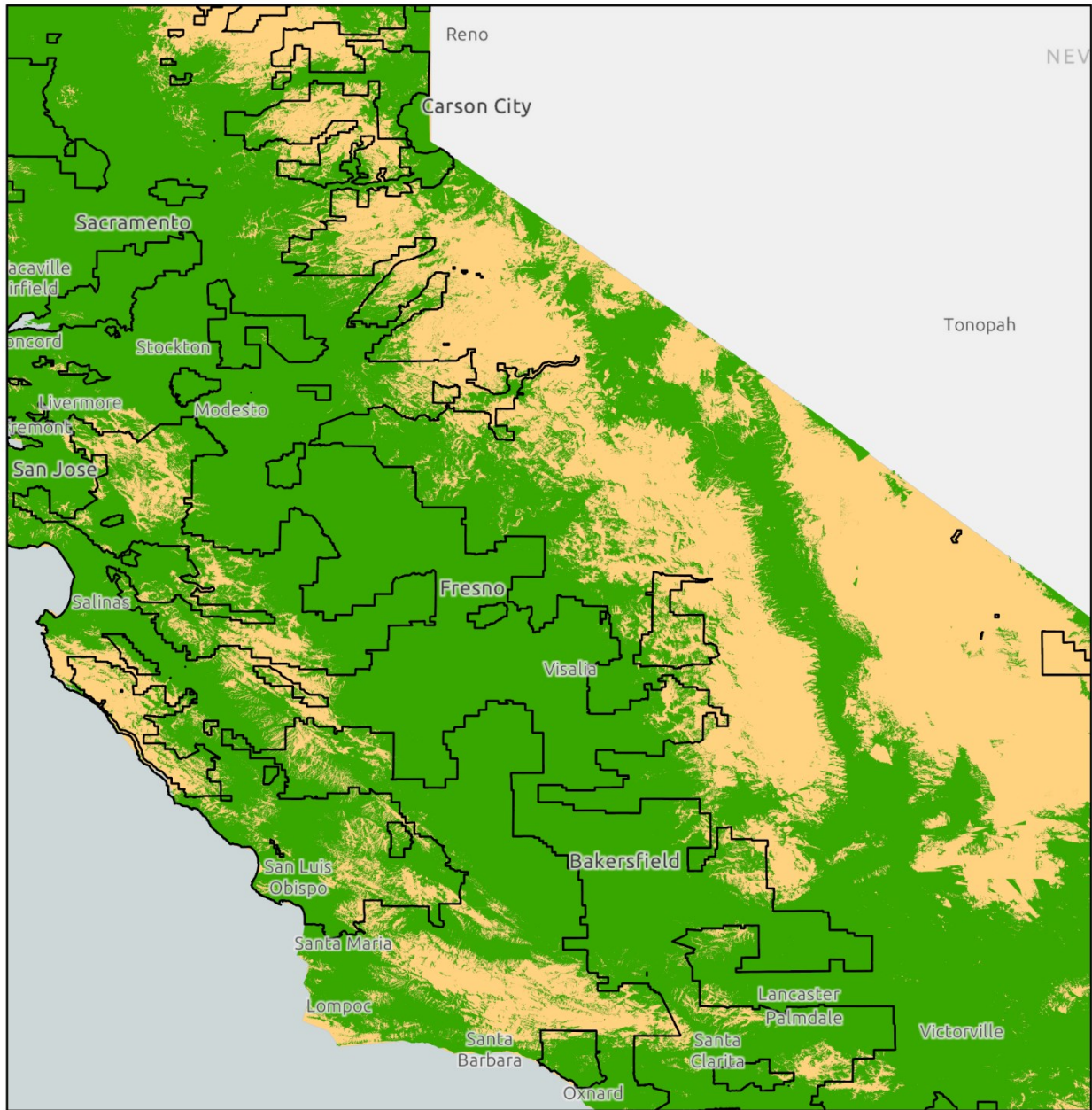

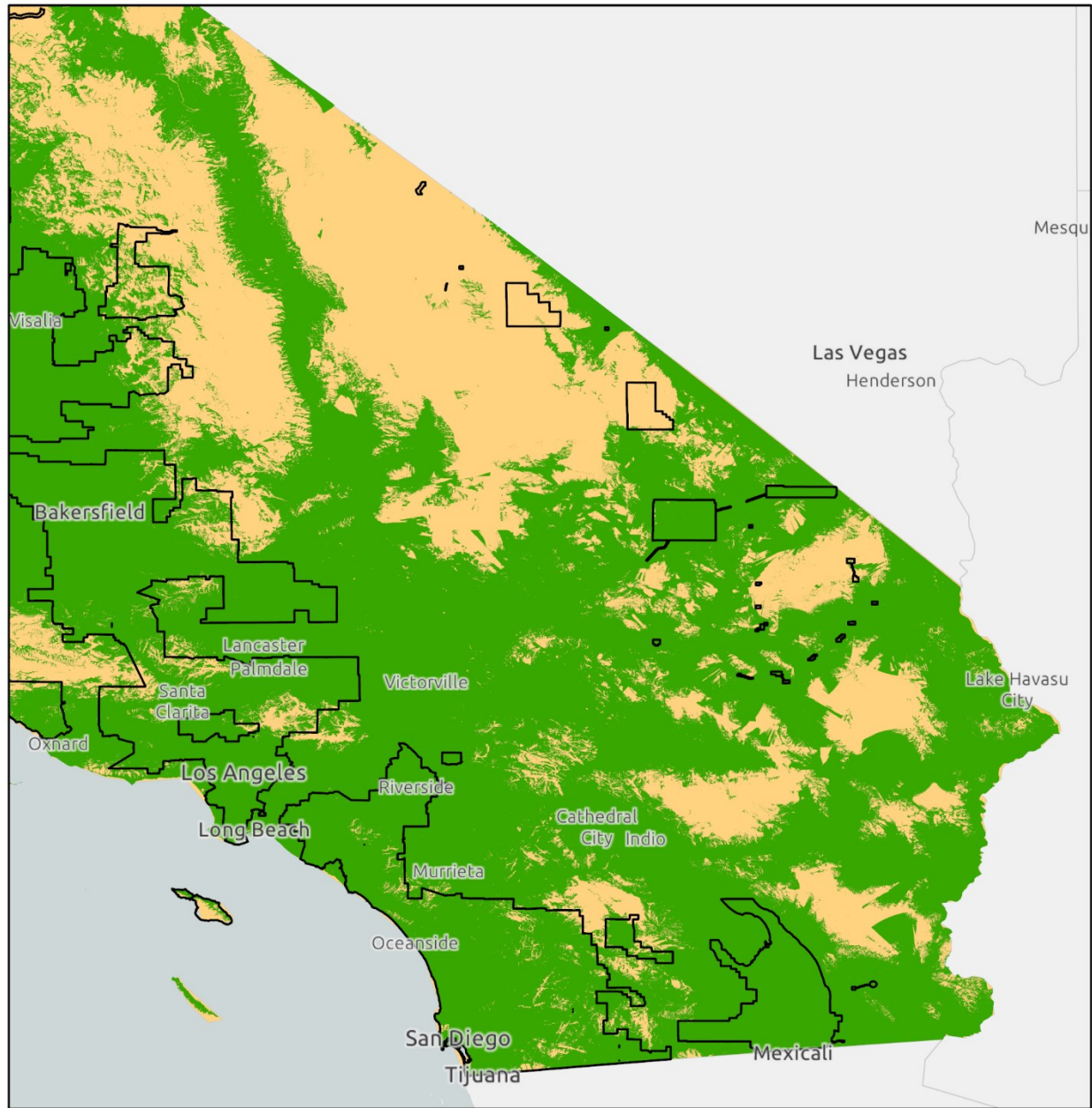

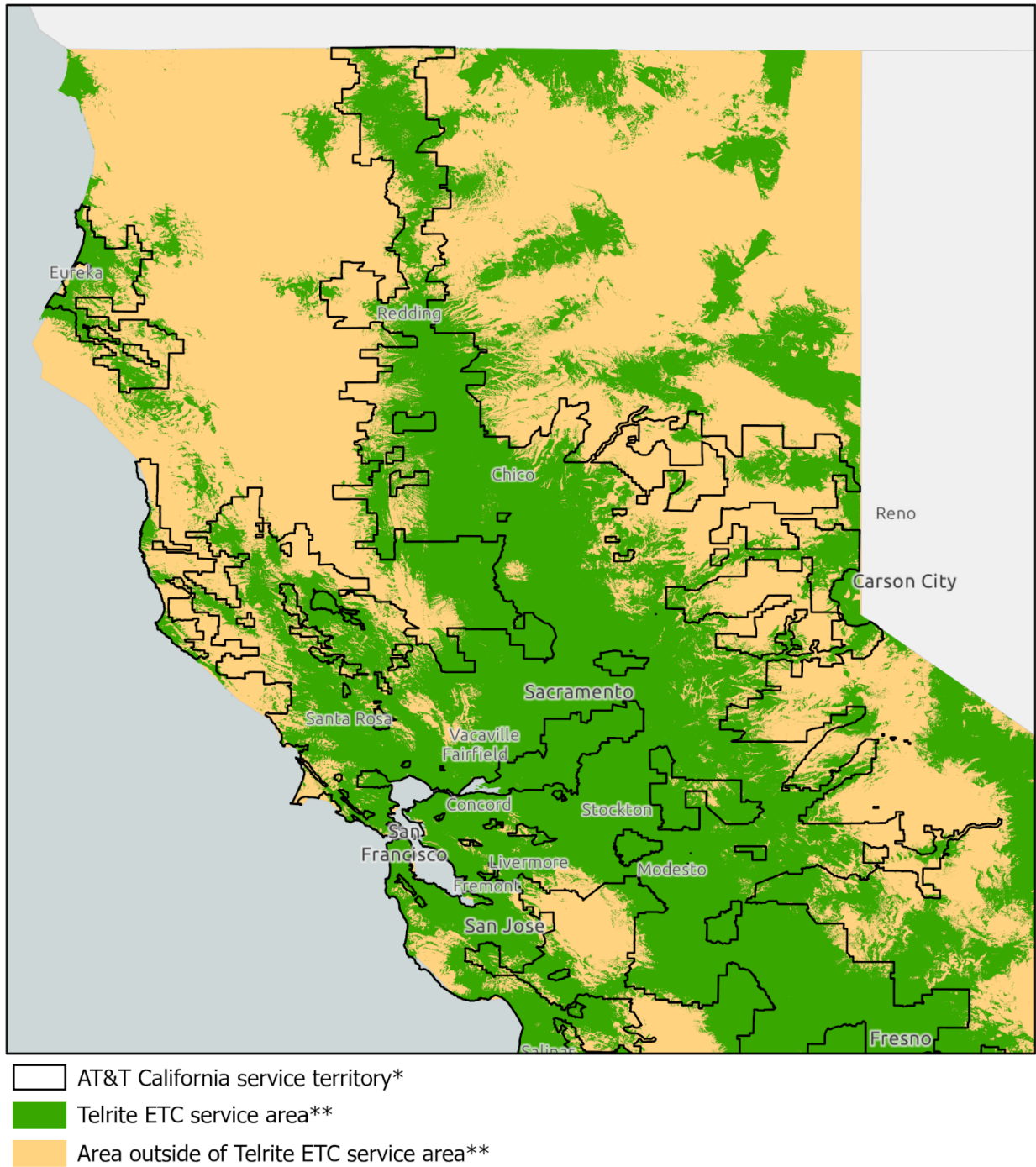

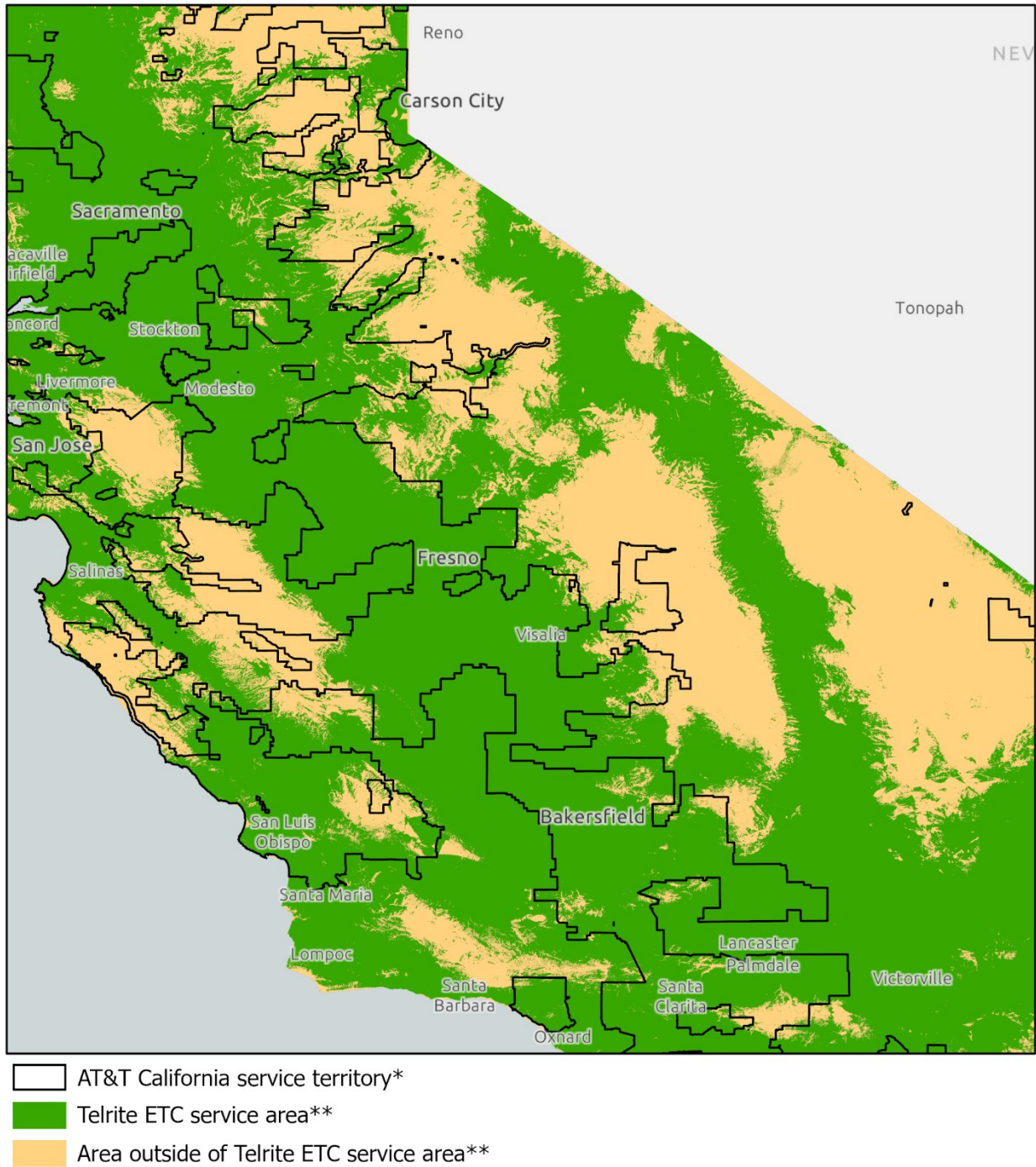

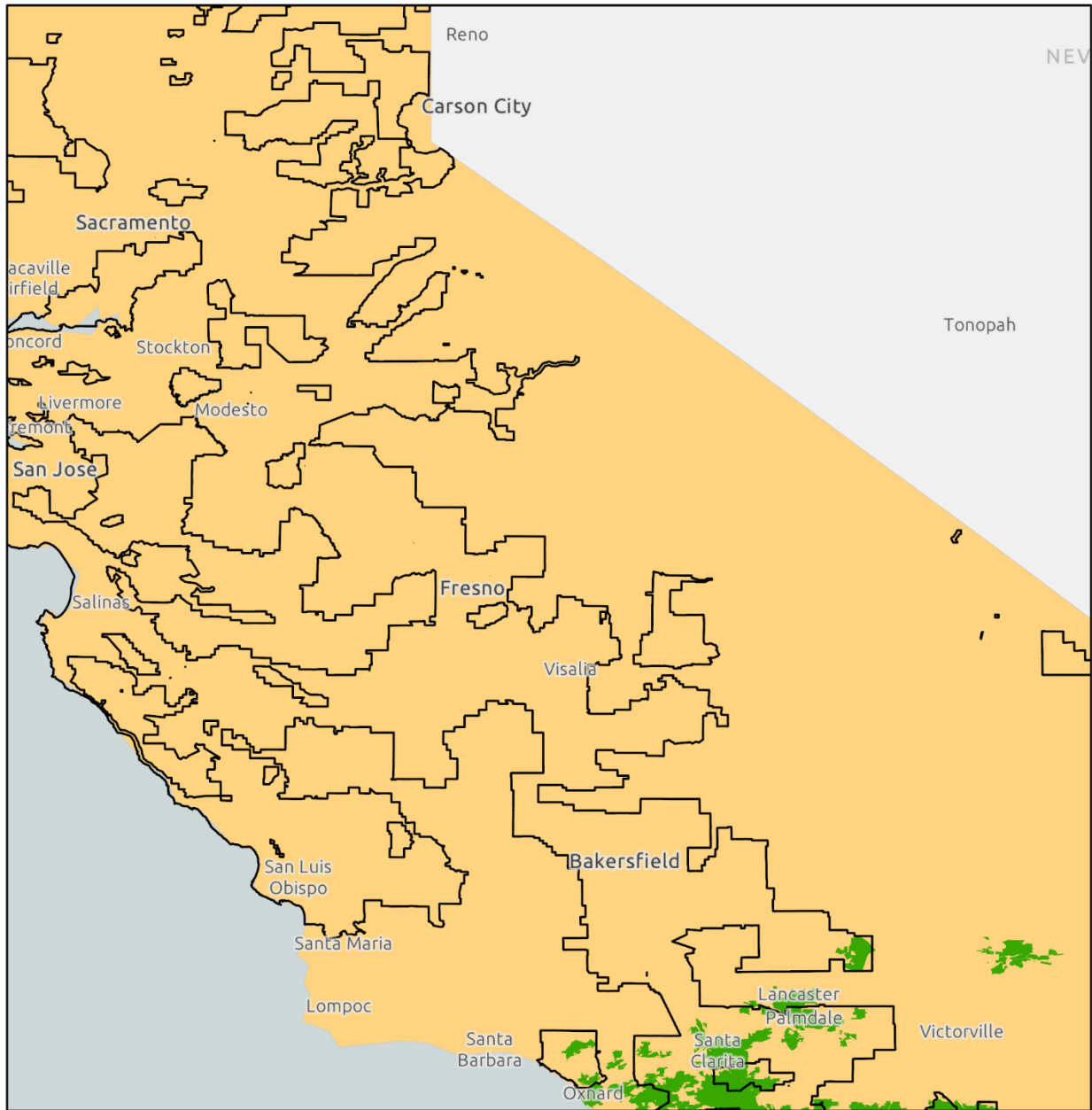

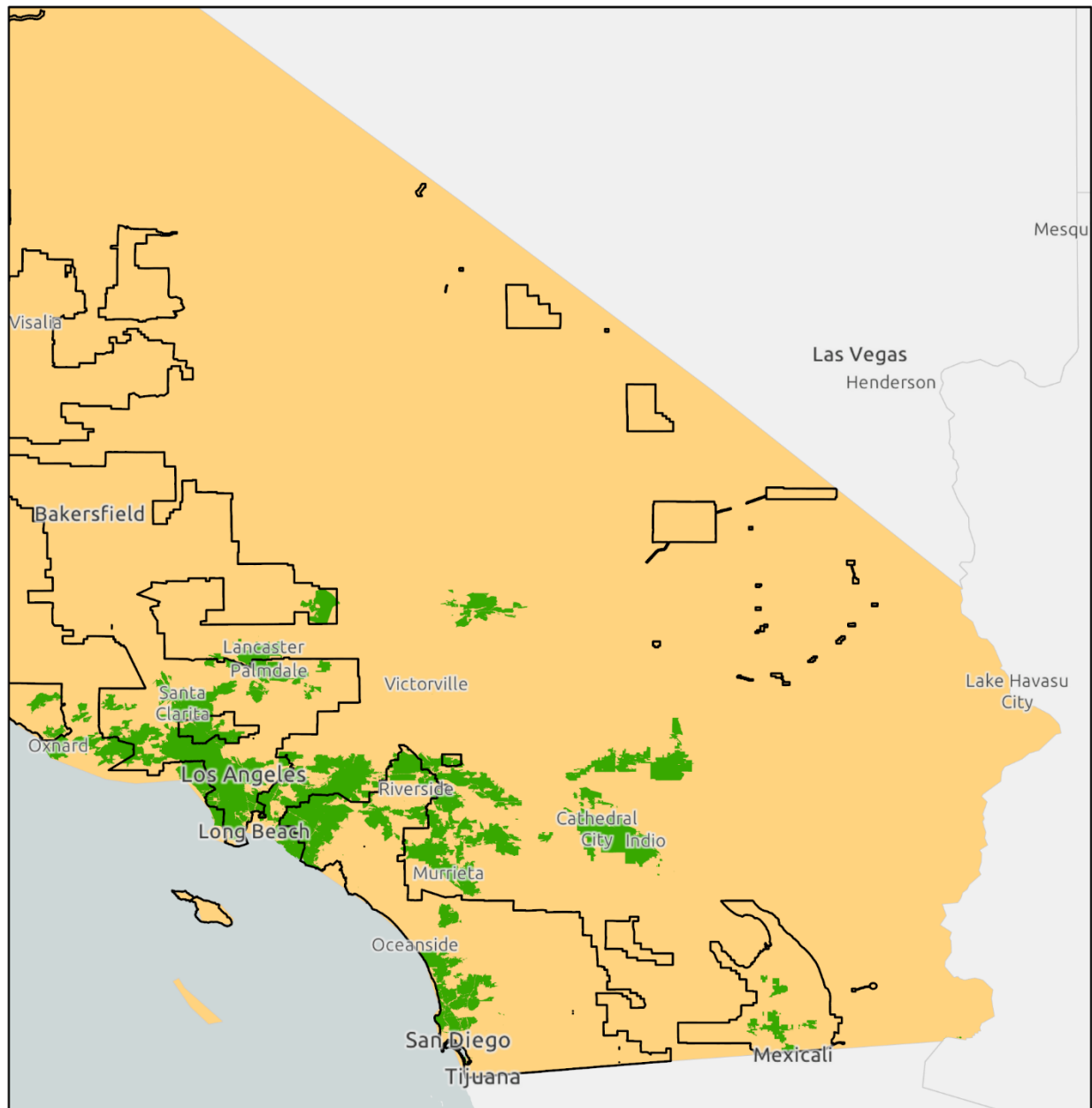

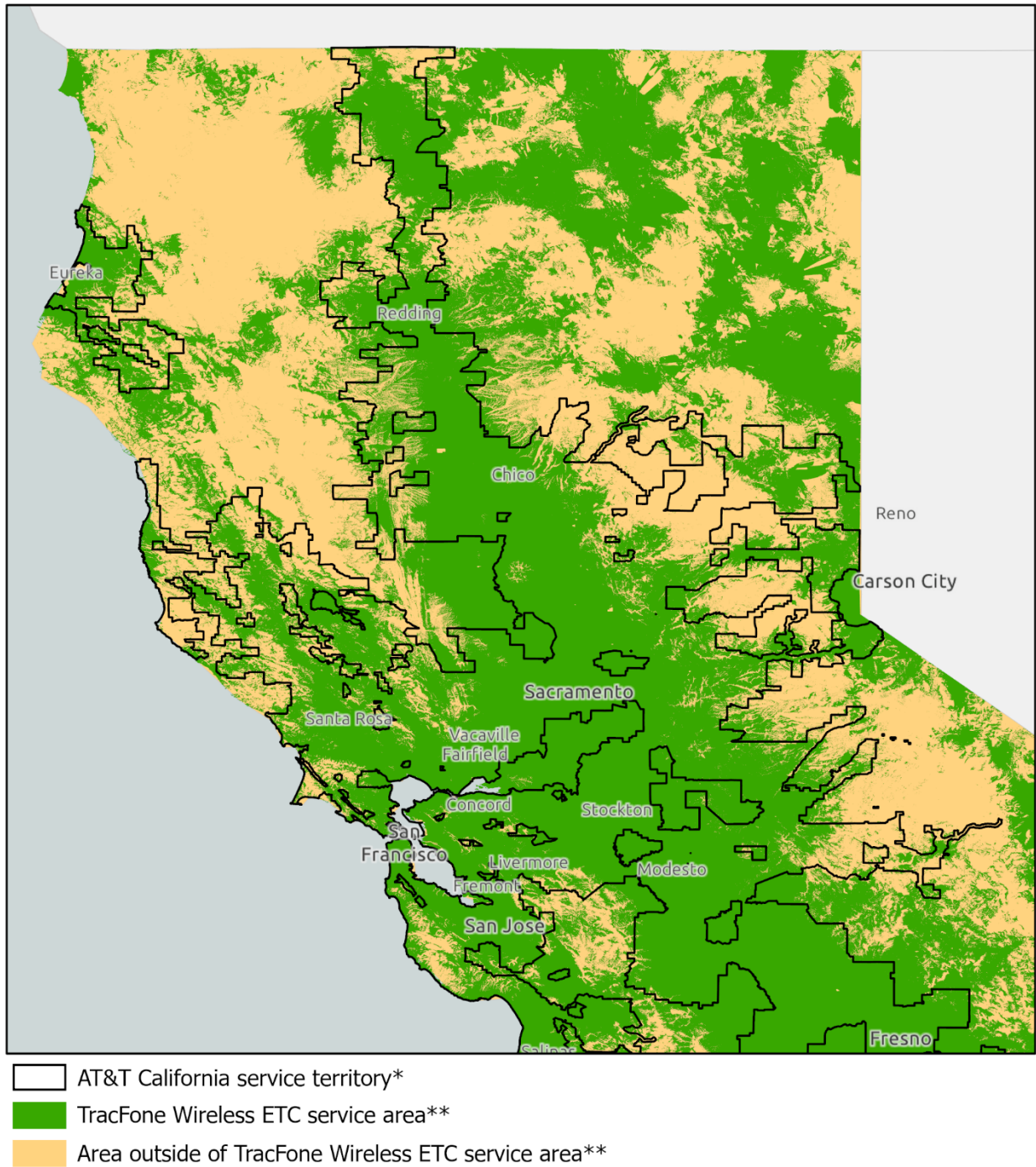
Coverage Map for TracFone Wireless ETC Service Area

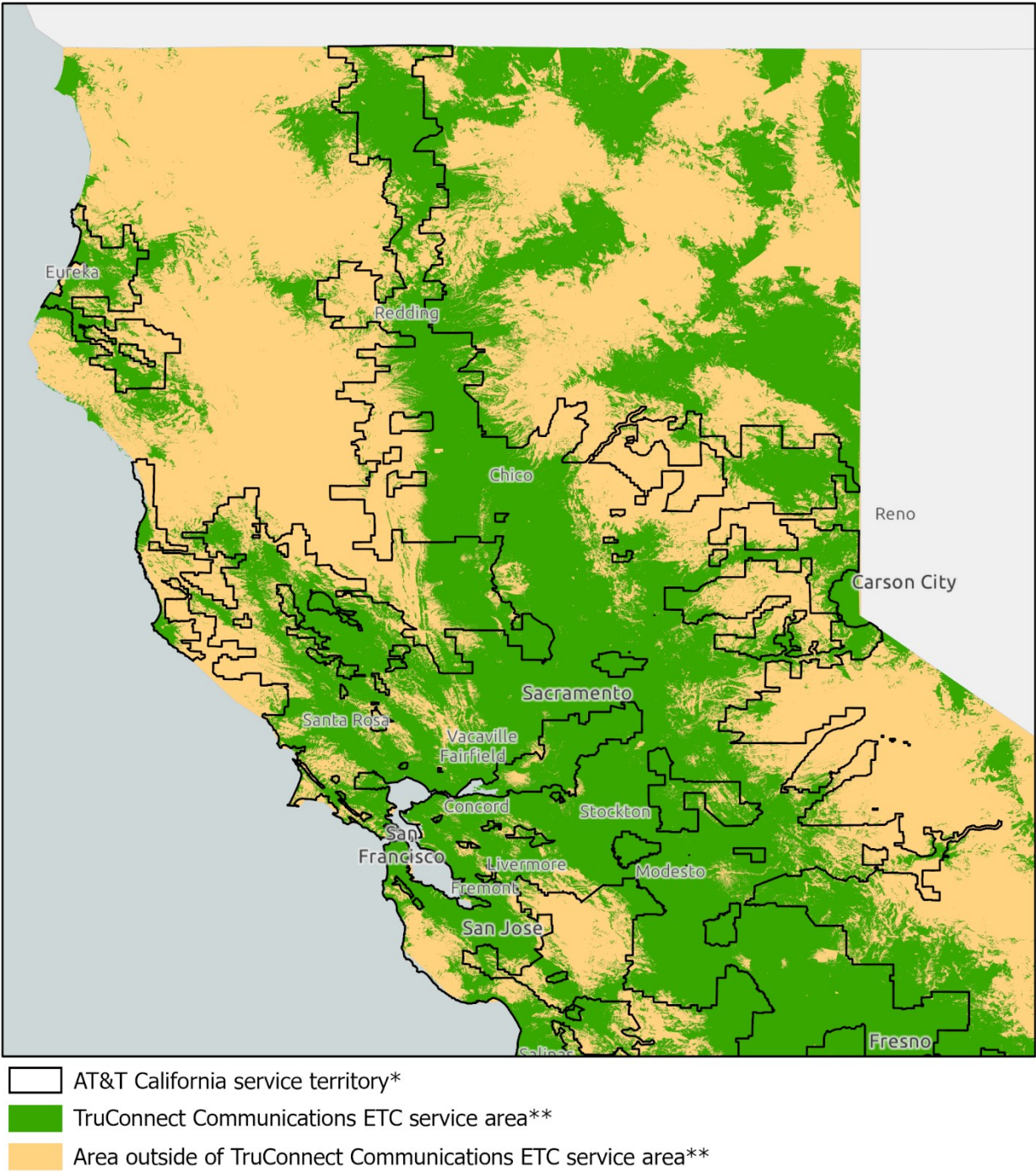

Coverage Map for TruConnect Communications ETC Service Area



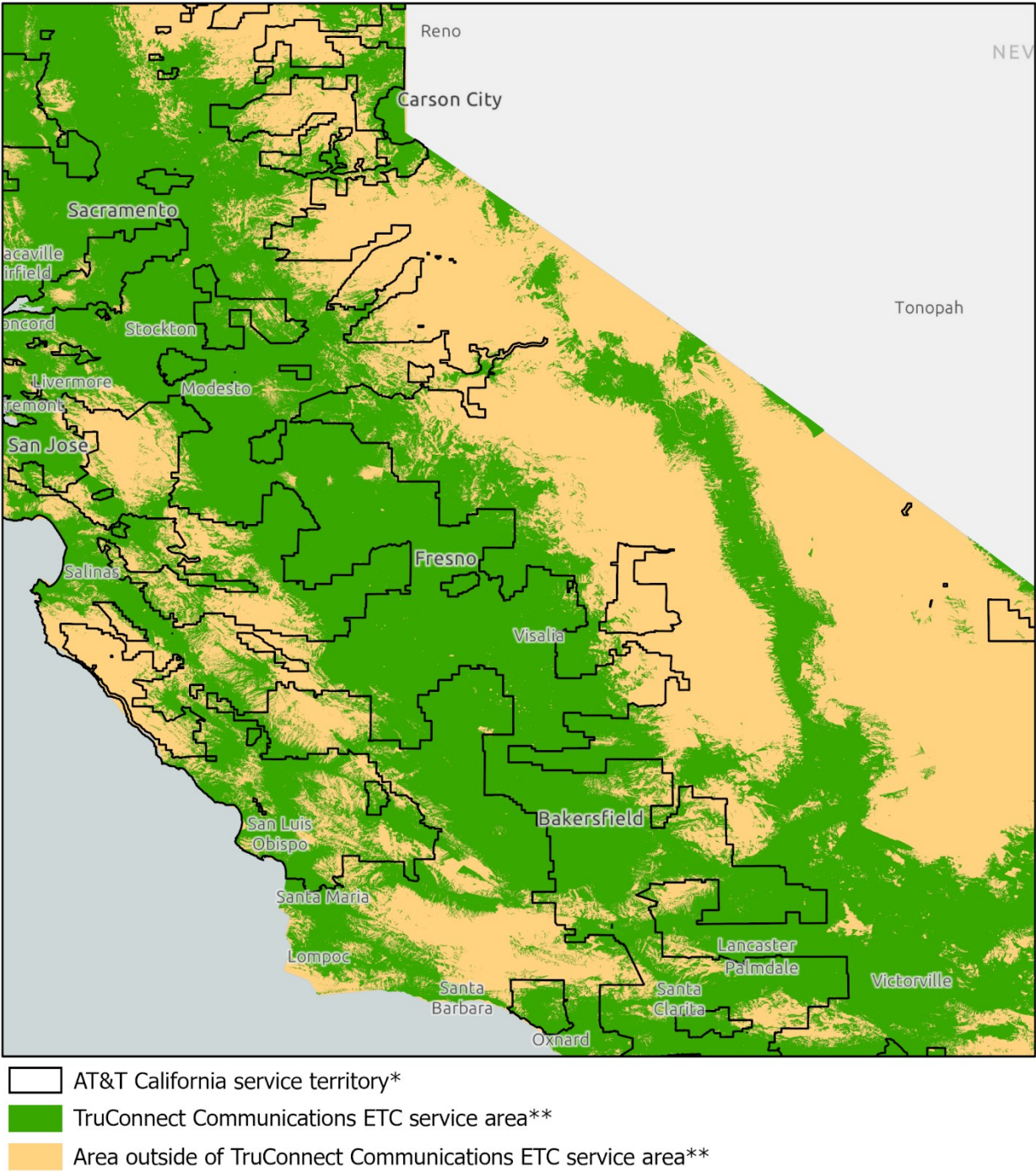

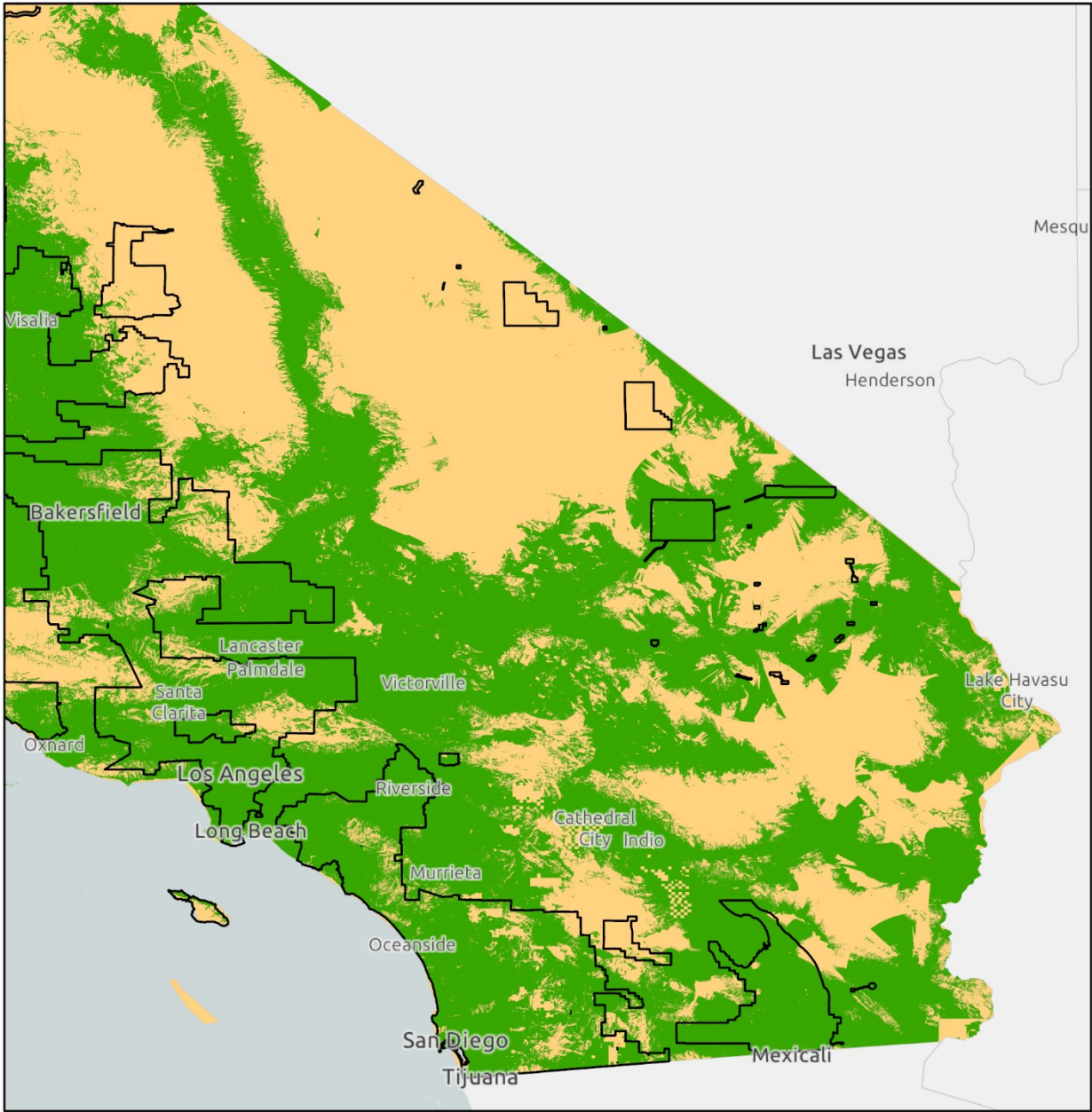
