2		EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

4	Q. 1.	What is the purpose of your testimony in this Application?
5		
6	A. 1.	As indicated in my Statement of Qualifications, I am the Vice President of Market
7		Transformation for Resource Innovations and am charged with leading all aspects
8		of the California Market Transformation Administrator (CalMTA) Program.
9		
10		In this Application, CalMTA requests that the California Public Utilities
11		Commission (Commission or CPUC) approve CalMTA's two Market
12		Transformation Initiatives (MTIs) included in the Application as MTI Plans. These
13		MTI Plans are for Room Heat Pumps and Induction Cooking and are included as
14		Appendix 1 and Appendix 2 to this Application. The approval of this Application
15		and the two MTI Plans will move CalMTA into the five-year implementation period
16		and will allow CalMTA to begin to make use of the \$250 million budget that the
17		Commission approved in Decision (D.) 19-12-021.1 The Application includes a
18		budget narrative and cost-estimates in Appendix 3, which will address how
19		CalMTA plans to allocate the \$250 million budget across the five-year
20		implementation period.
21		
22		The Application includes two procedural requests. The first request is that the
23		Commission eliminate the requirement for CalMTA to file an Annual Budget
24		Advice Letter (ABAL) for approval of future fiscal year funding or to forecast
25		future spending for CalMTA. The second request is that the Commission allow
26		CalMTA to use Tier 2 advice letters to approve future MTIs or discontinue them as
27		needed.

This exhibit also speaks to the structure and assumptions for CalMTA's five-year cost estimates that are detailed in 16 Appendix 3 of the Application. 17 18 Exhibit MTA-04, MTAB Recruitment, Conflict of Interest Protocols, 19 and Compensation, includes testimony that addresses how CalMTA 20 complied with OP 8 of D.19-12-021, which directed CalMTA to recruit the Market Transformation Advisory Board (MTAB) and establish 21 conflict of interest (COI) rules in consultation with Commission staff. 22 Exhibit MTA-05, MTI Total System Benefits and Cost Effectiveness, 23 24 includes testimony addressing the costs and benefits of the MTIs 25 included in this Application according to the Commission-approved 26 cost-effectiveness tests and energy savings as required by OP 10 of

D.19-12-021.

17	consult with MTAB and collaborate with the energy efficiency
18	(EE) program administrators (PAs) in developing the proposed
19	MTI Plans.
