## **QUESTION 007**

Referring to PG&E's rebuttal testimony page 3-6, lines 10-17: Please explain and provide workpapers demonstrating how PG&E proposes to calculate its monthly Sold RA and Unsold RA quantities for inclusion in the Indifference Amount template under its revised weighting proposal.

## ANSWER 007

PG&E's forecast of Sold RA and Unsold RA quantities will be based on the methodology described in Chapter 5 of PG&E's prepared testimony, but updated to only consider the forecast of both positions during the CAISO peak hour of each month based on PG&E's revised proposal to apply a 100% weighting to PG&E's SoD position during the CAISO peak hour of each month. The results were included in PG&E's Rebuttal testimony workpaper (PG&E 2026 ERRA Rebuttal Chapter 3 WP Tables 3-1 thru 3-13\_CONF.xlsx Tab: Table 3-13), which was based on the SoD position included in PG&E Prepared testimony.
