Footnotes

1. All energy saving values in this Revised Attachment G are from the Investor Owned Utilities' (IOUs') budget applications (PY 2009-2011 Planning Assumptions Table – Attachment A2). IOUs applications contained energy savings data which had primarily been gathered from the 2005 Impact Evaluation Report. The IOUs 2009 annual planned energy savings, as represented in their applications, have been divided by the total number of IOUs' estimated installations in 2009, for each measure the IOUs provided, to arrive at a corresponding approximate energy saving value for each household listed here. These energy savings figures on the Revised Attachment G are not exact energy savings values for each measure. However, they are reasonable approximations.

2. The Revised Attachment G is a "check list" for determining if the measure/measures qualify(ies) for installation under the modified "3 Measure Minimum Rule." The Revised Attachment G is also a reference available to the IOUs, the Commission, and interested stakeholders, in understanding what measures are available in qualifying a home for LIEE program service under the modified "3 Measure Minimum Rule." The Revised Attachment G is **NOT** intended to be used for calculation of actual IOU program energy savings - which currently uses a separate methodology not related to this table.

3. The Revised Attachment G is expected to be updated after the 2009 Impact Evaluation Report is released with more current energy savings figures.
4. The Revised Attachment G breaks down the previously grouped measures (in original Attachment G to D.08-11-031) to individual measures, as follows:
 - (a) New sections showing two umbrella measure groups were added to lists on the revised Attachment G: 1) Air Sealing and Envelope Repair, and 2) Water Heating Conservations. These measure groups were then broken down into sub groups;
 - (b) Air Sealing and Envelope Repair was subdivided into Outlet Cover Plate Gaskets, Evaporative Cooler/AC Cover, Attic Access Weatherization, Door Weather Stripping, Caulking, and Minor Home Repairs. The measure Air Sealing and Envelope Repair was assigned a value from the IOU budget applications (PY 2009-2011 Planning Assumptions Table – Attachment A2). The total measure group energy savings value was then divided by the number of sub measures in the group (6 sub measures), thereby, arriving at an average value serving as an approximate energy savings figure. This ‘average’ savings value was assigned across all individual measures in the group; and
 - (c) Water Heater Conservation was subdivided into Water Heater Blanket, Low Flow Showerhead, Water Heater Pipe Wrap, and Faucet Aerators. The measure Water Heater Conservation was assigned a value from the IOU budget applications (PY 2009-2011 Planning Assumptions Table – Attachment A2). The total measure group energy savings value was then divided by the number of sub measures in the group (4 sub measures), thereby, arriving at an average value serving as an approximate energy savings figure. This ‘average’ savings value was assigned across all individual measures in the group.
5. The Revised Attachment G corrects minor inaccuracies and removes several measures which were not part of the IOU budget applications (PY 2009-2011 Planning Assumptions Table – Attachment A2). The deleted measures are those measures IOUs did NOT propose and therefore had been inadvertently listed in the original Attachment G to D.08-11-031, without any corresponding energy savings values.
