SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. The customer will pay without refund the entire cost of installing the service connection.
2. The maximum diameter of the service connection will not be more than the diameter of the main to which the service is connected.

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3. The customer's installation must be such as to effectively separate the fire sprinkler system from that of the customer's regular water service. As a part of the sprinkler service installation there shall be a detector check with by-pass meter or other similar device acceptable to the company which will indicate the use of water. The utility may require a bi-annual test of the detector heck installation at customer cost as a condition of furnishing service. Any unauthorized use will be charged for at the regular established rate for general metered service, and/or may be grounds for the company's discontinuing the fire sprinkler service without liability to the company.
